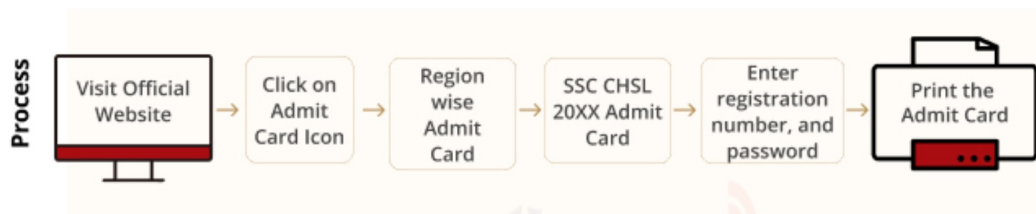

1. Visit the official SSC website or use the region-wise link provided.
2. Look for the **SSC CHSL Admit Card** option on the homepage, usually located at the top. Click on it and choose your respective region to go to the regional website.
3. Find and click on the "DOWNLOAD CALL LETTER CHSL Tier 1/ Tier 2" section.
4. Log in using your ID and password, created during registration.
5. After logging in, you'll be directed to your admit card link.

## SSC CHSL Tier 1 Exam Pattern

- Tier 1 is a Computer Based Examination (CBE).
- It comprises four subjects: English Language, Quantitative Aptitude, Logical Reasoning, and General Awareness.
- There are 100 questions, and each question carries 2 marks.
- The time allotted for Tier 1 is 60 minutes (80 minutes for scribe-eligible candidates).
- No negative marking for unattempted questions, but a 0.50 mark deduction for each wrong answer.

## SSC CHSL Tier 2 Exam Pattern

- After clearing Tier 1, candidates become eligible for Tier 2.
- Tier 2 is also a Computer Based Examination (CBE).
- Session I consists of 135 questions, with each question carrying 3 marks. The time allotted is 135 minutes.
- Session II involves a skill test or typing test module lasting 40 minutes.
- No negative marking for unattempted questions, but a 0.50 mark deduction for each wrong answer.
