SSC GD Constable Admit Card - CBE

First and foremost, it is important to note that Staff Selection Commission follows a pattern of releasing the admit card 10-15 days before the examination date. Furthermore, the admit cards are issued separately for all nine regions. Before presenting the admit card links for these regions, let's familiarize ourselves with the names of these areas:

1. Eastern Region
2. Karnataka Kerala Region
3. Southern Region
4. North Eastern Region
5. Western Region
6. Madhya Pradesh Region
7. Central Region
8. North Western Region
9. Northern Region

Keep in mind that to retrieve the SSC GD Constable admit card for the aforementioned regions, you will require your system-generated registration number and the password received during the application process.

Region Wise SSC GD Constable Admit Card

As stated in the previous section, the Staff Selection Commission releases the SSC GD Constable Admit Card individually for each of the nine regions. To facilitate your access, we have furnished direct links to the admit cards for each region below.

- Click the "Admit Card" icon located in the upper-right corner of the homepage.
- Now, a region-wise admit card page will open up.
- Select the link for your specific region, and you will be redirected to the corresponding regional website.
- Once you are through this step, access the website's admit card page.
- Thereafter, enter the required details, including your name, registration number, password, and so on.
- And there you have it, your SSC GD Constable admit card will be downloaded. Additionally, please be sure to save the PDF and take a printout of it.

Details Mentioned on SSC GD Constable Admit Card

The SSC GD Constable Admit Card contains essential details about both the examination and the candidate. Therefore, it is essential to cross-check the following information for accuracy:

- Candidate's Name
- Roll Number
- Date of Birth
- Exam Date and Time
- Exam Center and Address
- Candidate's Photograph and Signature
- Exam Day Guidelines

However, if you spot any discrepancy in your SSC GD Constable Admit Card, you must take the necessary actions to correct them. Hence, in the next segment, we have addressed this issue.

SSC GD Constable Admit Card: Steps to Admit Card Corrections

- **Contact the SSC Helpline:** Begin by reaching out to a regional office or contacting the official SSC helpline, the contact details of which can be found on the official SSC website. To simplify this process, we are providing you with the CRPF recruitment helpline number 011-26160255 for your convenience.
- **Provide Specifics:** Next, clearly outline the discrepancies observed on your SSC GD Constable admit card. This may include errors in the candidate's name, photograph, exam date, venue, or any other relevant information.
- **Provide Evidence:** Thirdly, it is advisable to keep all relevant documents that can support the request for correction. For example, having a copy of the application form with the correct name can be helpful if there is a misspelling.
- **Submit a Request:** Finally, submit the request for correction following the guidelines provided by the SSC helpline or regional office. This may involve sending an email.

SSC GD Constable - Important Exam Day Guidelines

Ensure you adhere to the guidelines below to avoid any last-minute chaos on the day of the SSC GD Constable examination.

- First and foremost, make certain you reach the examination centre well before the reporting time specified on your admit card.
- Above all, remember to carry the following documents along with your SSC GD Constable Admit Card: two coloured passport-size photographs and a valid photo ID proof such as Aadhaar Card, Voter's ID Card, Driving License, etc.
- Do not overlook the necessity of having all the essential documents emphasized in the SSC GD Constable Admit Card.
- Additionally, verify that the photograph and signature on your admit card are clearly visible.
- Furthermore, refrain from bringing prohibited items like electronic devices, study materials, or calculators to the examination centre.

SSC GD Constable Exam Pattern

The SSC GD Constable examination encompasses a Computer-Based Examination, succeeded by a Physical Efficiency Test (PET), a Physical Standard Test (PST), and ultimately, a Detailed Medical Examination (DME).

Moreover, let's delve into the allocation of marks for the subjects covered in the computer-based examination. The table presented below outlines the weightage assigned to each of these four aforementioned subjects:

Part-A	General Intelligence and Reasoning	20	40	60 minutes
Part-B	General Knowledge and General Awareness	20	40	
Part -C	Elementary Mathematics	20	40	
Part-D	English/ Hindi	20	40

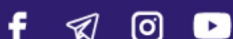
