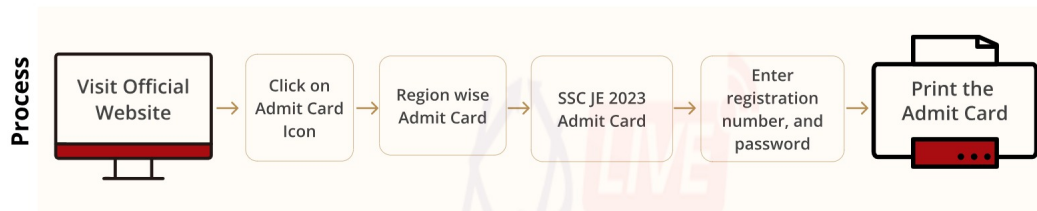

- Go to the [official SSC website](#).
- Locate the "Admit Card" icon in the top-right corner of the homepage.
- Click on the "Admit Card" icon. This will take you to a region-wise admit card page.
- Now, select the link of your respective region. You will be then redirected to the website of your Region.
- Once on the Region's website, navigate to the admit card section.
- Enter the required information, including your name, registration number, password, and any other requested details.
- After providing the necessary details, you can choose to either print the admit card or save it as a PDF file.

SSC JE 2023: Steps to Admit Card Corrections

- **Get in touch with the SSC Helpline:** The first step is to contact a regional office or the SSC's official helpline. On the official SSC website or in the [exam notification](#), candidates can discover their contact information.
- **Give Specifics:** Secondly, clearly describe the inconsistencies seen on your SSC JE admit card 2023. This could involve inaccuracies in the candidate's name, picture, exam date, location, or any other pertinent information.
- **Proof:** Thirdly, it is advised to keep all pertinent papers that can substantiate the claim for correction. For instance, having a copy of the application form with the proper name on it can be useful if the name is misspelt.
- **Submit Request:** Lastly, submit the request for correction, according to the guidelines given by the SSC helpline or regional office. This could entail sending email.

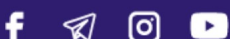
SSC JE 2023 - Important Exam Day Guidelines

For an easygoing and stress-free experience on the day of the SSC JE Exam 2023, adhere to these instructions

- Arrive at the exam centre well in advance of the reporting time specified on your admit card. This not only helps alleviate last-minute stress and anxiety but also allows you to compose yourself before the exam.
- Ensure you bring the subsequent documents along with your SSC JE admit card 2023:
 - Two coloured passport-size photographs.
 - Valid photo ID proof such as Aadhaar Card, Voter's ID Card, Driving License, etc.
- Make sure that the photograph and signature on your admit card are clear and distinct.
- Most importantly, refrain from bringing any restricted items such as electronic devices, study materials, or calculators to the exam centre.

SSC JE 2023 Exam Pattern

Understanding the exam pattern is vital as it enables students to grasp the exam's structure and format, aiding them in planning their study strategies effectively. Thus, let's delve into the SSC JE exam pattern for 2023.

- Both Paper 1 and Paper 2 will be Computer-Based Tests (CBT) featuring objective-type questions.
- Moreover, the duration for Paper-1 and 2 will be 2 hours each. However, candidates with benchmark disabilities will be getting 40 minutes extra.
- Additionally, Paper 1 will encompass three subjects, while Paper 2 will focus solely on one subject.
- Most importantly, there will be a penalty for incorrect answers, resulting in a deduction of one-third of the marks assigned to the respective question.
