Usually, SSC releases the admit card around 7 to 10 days prior to the examination on their [official website](#). Sticking to its trends, SSC released the SSC JHT admit card 2023 for paper 1 on **10th October 2023**. Those who have applied for the position of SSC Junior Hindi Translator 2023 will receive their SSC JHT Admit Card 2023 just at a single class in our upcoming segment.

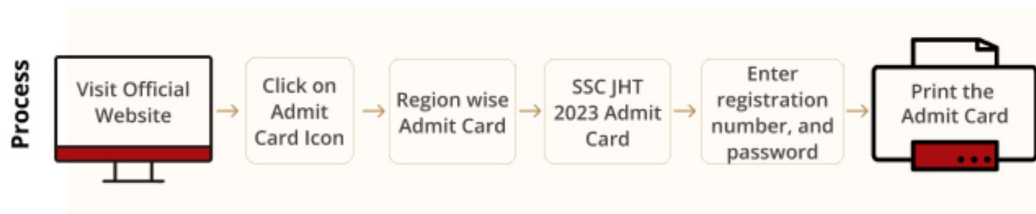

- **Contact SSC Regional/Sub-Regional Office:** If you spot any errors or discrepancies in your admit card, the first step is to contact the SSC Regional or Sub-Regional Office responsible for conducting the examination. You can find the contact details of the respective offices on the official SSC website.
- **Explain the Issue:** When you contact the SSC office, explain the specific issues or errors in your admit card. Clearly state what needs to be corrected, such as your name, date of birth, photograph, or exam center details. Provide any necessary supporting documents to validate the corrections you're requesting.
- **Submit Proof:** In many cases, the SSC office may require documentary proof to support your correction request. For example, if your name is misspelled, you might need to provide a copy of your valid ID with the correct spelling. Ensure you have all the necessary documents ready.
- **Follow their Instructions:** The SSC office will provide you with instructions on how to proceed with the correction process. This may involve submitting an application, documents, or visiting their office in person. Make sure to follow their guidance diligently.
- **Keep Records:** Maintain records of all communication with the SSC office, including emails, letters, or receipts for any documents submitted. This can be helpful in case there are any further issues or discrepancies.
- **Check the Updated Admit Card:** After the correction process is complete, make sure to download and verify the updated admit card to ensure that all corrections have been accurately made.

SSC JHT 2023 - Important Exam Day Guidelines

On the day of the test, candidates need to follow the rules that are written on the back of their SSC JHT admit card 2023. Listed below are some of the rules:

- Reach the exam center well ahead of the reporting time mentioned on the admit card.

- Moreover, do not carry any prohibited items like electronic devices, study materials, or calculators to the exam center.
- Follow all the exam hall instructions provided by the invigilators.

SSC JHT 2023 Exam Pattern

Let us now take you on a tour of the SSC JHT exam pattern for 2023. The recruitment exam for the SSC Junior Hindi Translator consists of two papers. One of which is a Computer Based Test while the other is a Descriptive Test. Moreover, the weightage of both papers is the same. But the pattern is slightly different. Let's decode the pattern in bullet points to make it easy to understand!

Paper- 1

- Paper I is a computer-based test with questions that can be answered in a number of ways.
- There are two parts to it: General English and General Hindi.
- There are 100 questions in each part, and the whole test takes 2 hours.
- For each bad answer, the student loses 0.25 points.

- Paper II is a pen-and-paper test with questions that ask you to describe things.
- This paper has questions about translation and writing an essay.
- In the translating section, candidates will have to interpret one passage from Hindi to English and one passage from English to Hindi.
- In essay writing, candidates have to write one article in Hindi and one in English.
