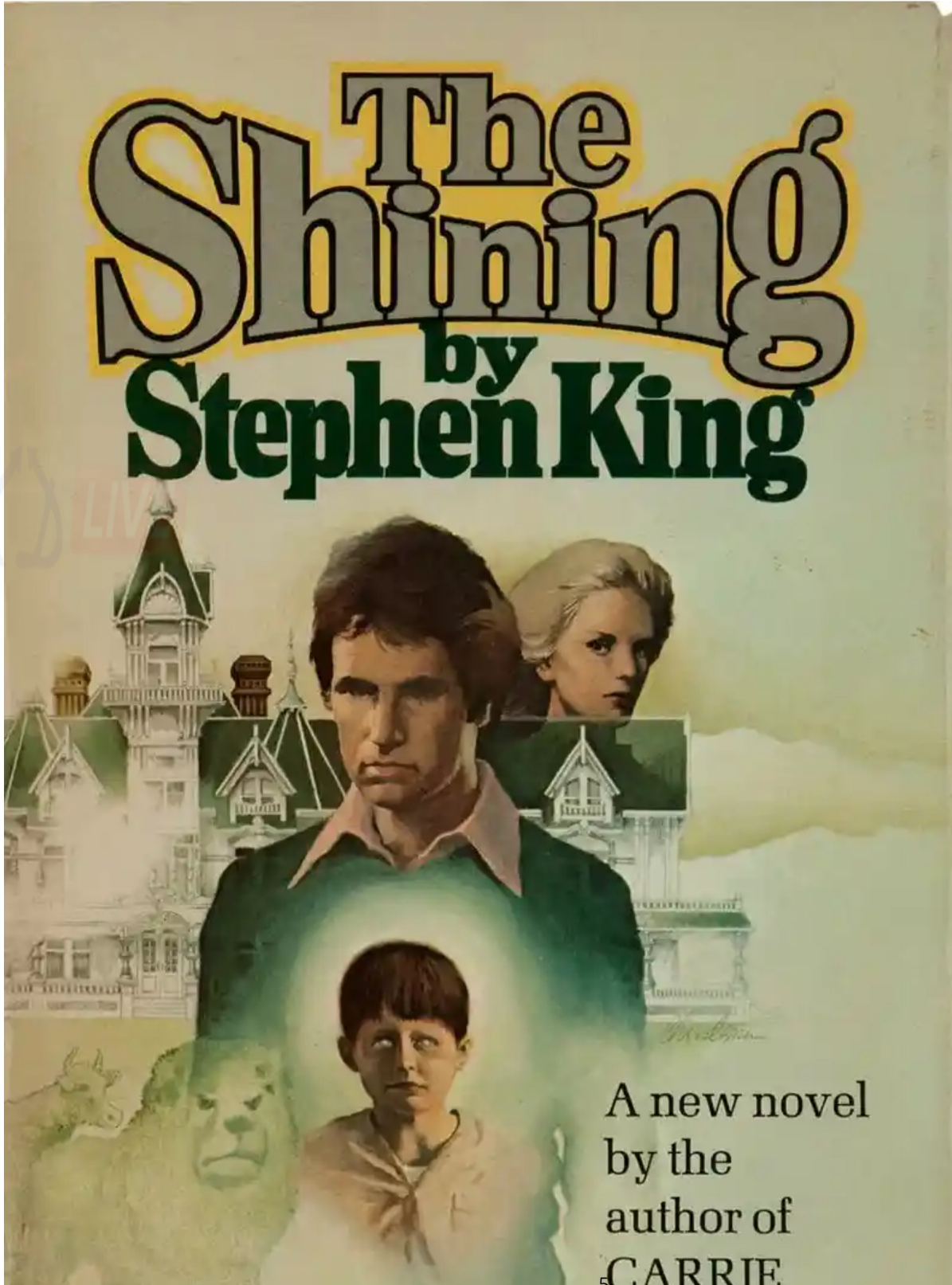
### The King of Horror: Stephen King
