# **Grom-E1 Missile**


The Grom-E1 Hybrid missile was recently used by Russian troops to hit Kharkiv in Ukraine. It is an air to surface Soviet era Kh-38 missile that combines features of both missile and aerial bomb. The missile has a maximum range of 120km and consists of a high explosive modular warhead equipped with a contact detonator. The missile was officially unveiled by Russia in 2018.

With this move Odisha has become the only state in India to provide such rights to the highest number of PVTGs. Saora Tribe is mentioned in Ramayana and Mahabharata and is called by various names like Savaras, Savaras, Saura and Sora etc. They have their own native language called Sora and script called Sorang Sompeng.




