Department of Justice to launch Tele-Law 2.0



The event is seminal as it commemorates the reaching of 50 lakh milestone that earmarks rendering of pre litigation advice to the common citizens through use of technology

54th Network Planning Group (NPG) Group Meeting held


The 54th Network Planning Group (NPG) Group Meeting chaired by Special Secretary, Logistics, DPIIT, Smt. Sumita Dawra held at New Delhi. Two projects of the Ministry of Railways and two roadways projects with a total cost of 7693 crore were assessed. The meeting stressed upon the importance of utilising the GatiShakti National Master Plan Portal.

Key Points:

- A) NPG examined Thiruvananthapuram Outer ring road (ORR) under Bharatmala Pariyojana in Kerala worth 4767 crore.
- B) The project will improve the road network, benefitting the local people by reducing time travel.
- C) NPG also deliberated on a new broad gauge Railway line between Pushkar-Merta in Rajasthan. It will provide direct connectivity from Central India to Northern India as well as to Western border.

Pelma to become SECLs first Opencast mine


SECLs Pelma will become the first Opencast mine in Chhattisgarh under MDO (Mine Developer and Operator) mode. SECL signed an agreement with Pelma Collieries to operate the Pelma Opencast mine located in the Raigarh area. Over 219 million tonnes of coal to be Extracted from the mine during a 20 year period.

Key Points:

- A) Pelma Collieries will be responsible for all the activities related to designing, financing, procurement, construction, operation and maintenance of project
- B) High quality G-12 grade coal will be Extracted from the mine.
- C) MDO mode is a novel concept of mine operation under which the Government and private enterprises will work together to fulfil the country's energy needs.

Hun Manet appointed as new PM of Cambodia



FDA approved RSV Vaccine Abrysvo


The United States became the first country in the world to approve a vaccine for pregnant women that prevents severe diseases caused by Respiratory Syncytial Virus (RSV). It will protect the infants room RSV. It was first approved for individuals aged 60 years and older to prevent LRTD caused by RSV.

Key Points:

- A) Abrysvo is administered to pregnant women during gestational weeks 32 to 36 via single dose injection.
- B) RSV is a highly contagious virus that causes Respiratory infections across age groups.
- C) Abrysvo showed 81.8 percent reduction in severe LRTD risk within 90 days after birth.

About FDA:

Report on stalled real estate projects submitted


The 14 member committee setup by Union Housing and Urban Affairs submitted its report on stalled real estate projects to the Ministry. The committee was chaired by former NITI Aayog CEO and India's G20 Sherpa Amitabh Kant. Report revealed that 60 percent of these projects represented a capital commitment of 1.9 lakh crore had been purchased.

Key Points:

- A) The committee included officials of the Finance Ministry, UP and Haryana State Government, I&B Board of India, the NHB and RERA of Haryana and UP.
- B) Report emphasised the primary cause of project distress was a lack of financial viability, resulting in cost overruns and delays.
- C) The recommendations fall under the State Jurisdiction.

Iran unveils Mohajer-10 Attack Drone


Iran unveils new version of the Mohajer a day after Israeli PM blames Iran for recent attacks. It was introduced at a ceremony in Tehran attended by President Ibrahim Raisi. It is a domestically built Drone with improved capabilities like higher altitude, longer endurance and increased payload capacity.

Key Points:

- A) The Drone can fly up to 24 hours, at altitudes of 7000 metres and cover a range of 2000 km.
- B) It is equipped with advanced electronic and intelligence systems and can reach speeds of 210 km per hour.
- C) Introduction of Mohajer-10 showcases Iran's technological advancements in Drone technology.

Pench Tiger Reserve introduced Cycle Safari



LCA Tejas successfully test fires ASTRA Missile

Light Combat Aircraft (LCA) Tejas successfully fired the indigenous ASTRA beyond visual range air to air Missile off the Goa Coast. LCA Tejas is the lightest, smallest and tailless multi role Supersonic fighter aircraft in its class. The Missile release was successfully carried out from the aircraft at an altitude of 20,000 ft.
