First-Ever Case of Down Syndrome in Neanderthals

Researchers have documented the first case of Down syndrome in Neanderthals, revealing altruistic behaviour in caring for a child named Tina, who had severe disabilities. Found at Cova Negra, Spain, this discovery highlights Neanderthal empathy and complex social structures. Down syndrome, a condition caused by an extra copy of chromosome 21, results in developmental delays and physical challenges. It arises from an error in cell division during foetal development rather than being inherited.

NITI Aayog Issues Guidelines on Steel Slag Road

NITI Aayog recently issued guidelines to promote the use of processed steel slag aggregates in road construction. Steel slag, a byproduct of steel manufacturing from electric arc furnaces or basic oxygen furnaces, consists mainly of calcium, magnesium, manganese, and aluminium silicates and oxides. Its applications include treating waste sites and replacing coarse aggregate in construction.

Researchers in France have discovered that zinc plays a vital role in supporting the health of legume crops by facilitating nitrogen fixation, which is essential for their growth. They identified a transcription factor, Fixation Under Nitrate (FUN), regulated by zinc, which controls nodule breakdown in response to environmental factors like soil nitrogen levels.

ADITYA-L1 Completes First Halo Orbit Around L1 Point of Sun-Earth






