Gas Flaring Tracker Report 2024


According to the World Bank's Gas Flaring Tracker Report, gas flaring, i.e., burning natural gas during oil extraction, reached its highest level since 2019 in 2023. This wasteful practice, driven by economic constraints and lack of regulation, releases harmful greenhouse gases and air pollutants. Gas flaring can be mitigated by re-injecting the excess gas back into the ground or using it as a resource for electricity production.



Container Port Performance Index (CPPI) 2023

In the latest Container Port Performance Index (CPPI) 2023, released by the World Bank and S&P Global Market Intelligence, nine Indian ports have achieved positions within the top 100 globally. This benchmark assesses ports according to productivity, efficiency, and reliability, with Yangshan and Salalah ports emerging as top performers in the rankings. Visakhapatnam Port secured a notable 19th position, a significant jump from its previous rank.

Chad becomes the latest country to eliminate Sleeping Sickness

Recently, Chad became the 51st country to eliminate the Gambiense form of Human African Trypanosomiasis (HAT). Commonly known as sleeping sickness, it is a parasitic disease transmitted by tsetse flies in sub-Saharan Africa. There are two forms: Trypanosoma brucei gambiense and Trypanosoma brucei rhodesiense. Symptoms include fever, headaches, and joint pain, and early treatment is crucial as the disease can be fatal if untreated.

World's Highest Railway Bridge

Crossing Chenab at 1,178 feet, taller than the Eiffel Tower, it's integral to the Udhampur-Srinagar-Baramulla rail link. Its innovative design enhances durability and reduces maintenance needs.

New Zealand Scraps 'Burp Tax'

New Zealand recently announced the cancellation of the 'burp tax,' a measure aimed at taxing greenhouse gas emissions from livestock. Introduced in October 2022, the tax targeted methane emissions from ruminant animals like cattle and sheep, significant contributors to New Zealand's greenhouse gas output. Farmers opposed the tax, citing concerns over its impact on their livelihoods amid existing agricultural emission regulations.

Successful Launch of Space Variable Object Monitor (SVOM) Satellite

SVOM, a French-Chinese satellite, was recently launched from China's Xichang Satellite Launch Centre. SVOM aims to detect and analyse gamma-ray bursts (GRBs), which originate from massive star explosions and compact star mergers that provide valuable data for understanding the universe's history and evolution. With a planned operational lifespan of up to 20 years, SVOM aims to unravel GRB mysteries, including detecting the most distant and earliest ones and testing physics laws under extreme conditions.

Researchers from the University of Gothenburg discovered that a significant volume of methane released from the damaged Nord Stream pipelines in the Baltic Sea did not escape into the atmosphere as previously believed. Researchers discovered that a large portion dissolved into the Baltic Sea, highlighting the complexity of methane's environmental impact. Methane, a potent greenhouse gas, contributes significantly to global warming and is associated with various sources including agriculture and fossil fuels.

World Investment Report 2024

The 2024 World Investment Report by UN Trade and Development (UNCTAD) revealed a 2% decline in global foreign direct investment (FDI) in 2023. Developing countries were hit harder with a 7% decrease, primarily due to lower investments in Asia. While infrastructure and digital sectors saw reduced FDI, manufacturing and critical minerals experienced growth. The report emphasises the need for increased investment to achieve Sustainable Development Goals.
