## India's External debt increase by USD 39.7 billion

The Reserve Bank of India recently informed that India's External debt grew to USD 663.8 billion. There was an increase of USD 39.7 billion over its level at the end March 2023. The External Debt to GDP Ratio declined to 18.7 percent. The largest component of External debt was Loans followed by Currency Deposits, Trade credit and advances and debt securities.

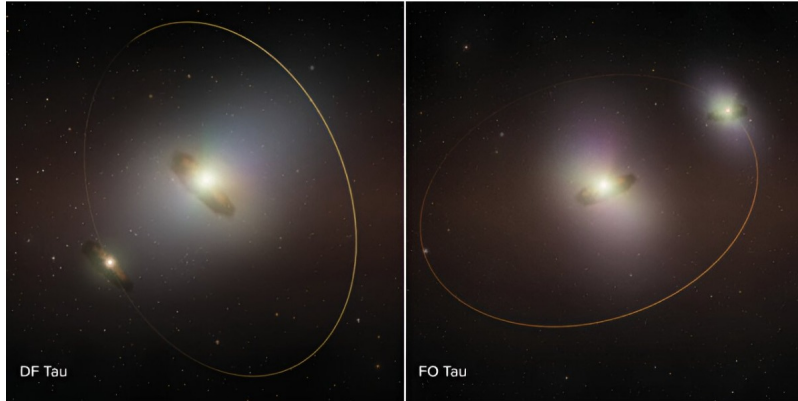

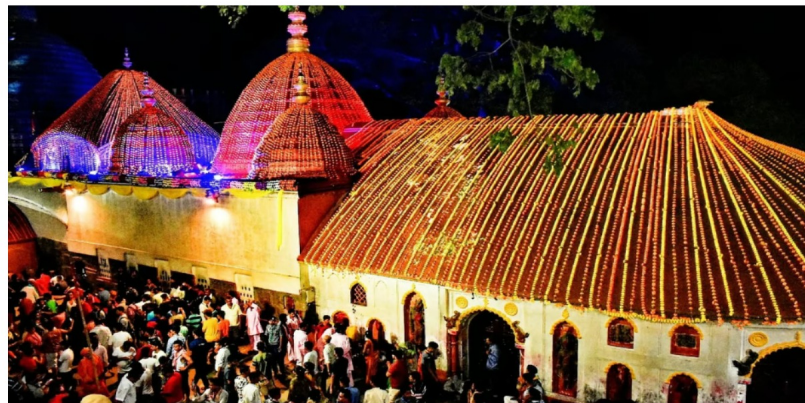
