Pallikaranai Marshland

To protect the deteriorating Pallikaranai marshland, the Tamil Nadu government plans to construct a high-level bridge between Kamatchi Hospital and Thoraipakkam. Despite threats from constructions and encroachments, birds still flock to Pallikaranai marshland. This Ramsar site serves as a crucial flood buffer and supports diverse wildlife. The marshland's hydrology and biodiversity are influenced by the Bay of Bengal and the North East Monsoon.

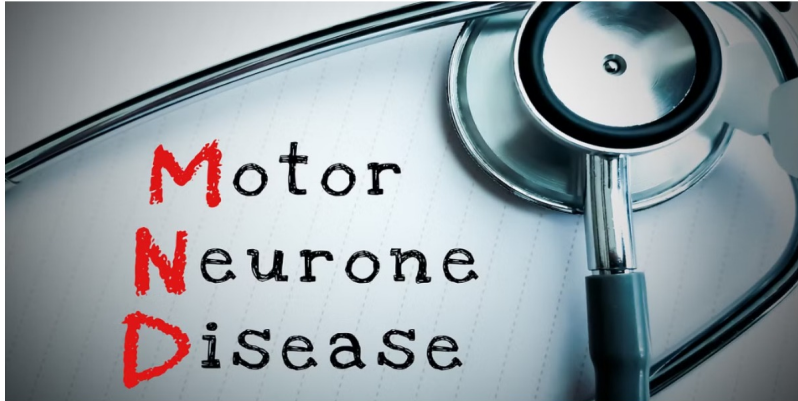

Scheme for Partial Reimbursement of Exploration Expenses for Holders of Exploration Licences (EL)

The Ministry of Mines has introduced a program to reimburse half of the exploration costs incurred by holders of exploration licences, with a maximum reimbursement limit of ₹20 crore. The scheme, funded by the National Mineral Exploration Trust, aims to boost private sector participation in exploring critical minerals. Reimbursements are available in six stages, covering various exploration activities. However, the reimbursed amount must be returned to the trust once mineral production begins.

Juno Probe of NASA

NASA's Juno probe has unveiled extensive lava lakes on Jupiter's moon Io, enhancing our understanding of its volcanic activity. Launched in 2011, Juno's mission aimed to explore Jupiter's moons along with the planet itself. Despite completing its primary mission in 2021, Juno continues to explore the Jupiter system, providing valuable insights into celestial phenomena.

Microwave Obscurant Chaff rocket of DRDO

Recently, the Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) delivered the Medium Range-Microwave Obscurant Chaff Rocket (MR-MOCR) to the Indian Navy in New Delhi. Developed by DRDO's Defence Laboratory in Jodhpur, this technology uses specialised fibres to create a microwave shield, obscuring radar signals and enhancing defence against radio frequency threats.

Bhuvan Panchayat Geoportal 4.0

Union Minister of State for Science and Technology recently launched two geo-portals: Bhuvan Panchayat (Ver. 4.0) and National Database for Emergency Management (NDEM Ver. 5.0). Bhuvan Panchayat, developed by the National Remote Sensing Centre (NRSC) under ISRO, supports spatial planning up to Gram Panchayat level with geospatial data. NDEM enhances disaster management with a comprehensive national geospatial database and decision support tools.

Vulnerable Mainland Serow Located at Lowest Elevation in Assam

In Raimona National Park, Assam, scientists recorded a lone mainland serow, a vulnerable mammal found at altitudes of 200-3,000 metres. This solitary mammal, resembling a blend of goat and antelope, was sighted at 96 metres above sea level, underscoring its habitat's conservation significance. This is the first photographic evidence of the species in the park.

Successful Trial of ABHYAS

The Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) recently achieved a milestone with six successful developmental trials of the High-Speed Expendable Aerial Target (HEAT) 'ABHYAS' in Chandipur, Odisha. ABHYAS, developed by DRDO's Aeronautical Development Establishment, is an indigenously developed autonomous target drone, designed to simulate realistic threat scenarios for weapon systems practice and features autonomous flight capabilities, aided by advanced navigation and control systems.
