
Key Points:

Key Points:


Key Points:

GRAP-2 invoked in Delhi


The Commission for Air Quality Management (CAQM) invoked Stage 2 of Graded Response Action Plan (GRAP) as the Air Quality index (AQI) reached 248 in Delhi. The Air Quality of Delhi-NCR has worsened in the past few days and it may reach Very poor Category as per IMD and Indian Institute of Tropical Meteorology.

Key Points:

- A) The AQI is close to the category of 301- 400 and is expected to touch these levels by Monday or Tuesday.
- B) Delhi Pollution Control Board and other pollution control boards in the NCR region are responsible for the implementation of guidelines of GRAP.
- C) The government takes steps like increasing the parking fees to discourage the use of personal vehicles and increasing the frequency of CNG/Electric buses and metros.

About CAQM:

South Korea, Japan and US to hold first joint Air drills


South Korea, the United States and Japan conducted their first joint aerial drills as part of their defence cooperation against North Korea's Missile and nuclear threats. The exercise involved a US Nuclear weapons capable B-52 bomber.

Key Points:

- A) The US bomber landed at a South Korean airbase on Tuesday at the country's largest defence exhibition.
- B) The trilateral exercise took place south of the Korean peninsula where Seoul and Tokyo's air defence identification zones overlap.
- C) B-52s which fly at subsonic speeds can travel more than 8,800 miles without refuelling at an altitude reaching 50,000 feet.

Alaskan Snow Crabs disappear due to Warmer Oceans

Billions of Snow Crabs have disappeared from Alaskan waters for which scientists have blamed the rising ocean temperatures. The most recent discoveries of the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) shed light on the unexpected loss of snow Crabs resulting in postponement of snow crab harvest.

Key Points:


compelling connection between marine heat waves in the eastern Bering Sea and the mysterious disappearance of snow crabs.

B) Overfished is a technical definition triggering conservation measures by leaving the actual cause of the collapse unexplained.

Warmer temperatures and higher population density were identified as factors significantly linked to increased mortality among mature snow crabs.

Helium-3 found in rocks on Baffin Island

A recent study examining lava flows on Baffin Island in the Arctic archipelago has found high levels of Helium 3, a rare isotope associated with earth's core. It suggests that the Earth's Core may be leaking. The Discovery implies a greater level of dynamism in the Earth's deep interior.


Key Points:

The Earth's mantle is not a static entity, but it continuously brings lava to the surface while consuming parts of the Earth.

- B) This discovery challenges the conventional understanding that the core and outer layers of the planet including the mantle and crust are geochemically isolated.
- C) This may be leaking out of the Earth's core, potentially reshaping our understanding of the Earth's inner workings.

About Earth's Core:

- A) It is the innermost geological layer of the planet.



Rare Paintbrush Swift Butterfly


A rare Paintbrush Swift Butterfly has been documented for the first time in Himachal Pradesh's Chamba district. The State is home to 25 percent of the butterfly species found in India. 120 species of butterflies have been documented by the Wild Bhattiyat Project initiated by the State Forest Department in 2022.

Key Points:

- A) The State supports around 430 butterfly species or about 25% of the total number of butterfly species found in India.
- B) The paintbrush swift (*Baoris farri*) is a butterfly species of the Hesperiidae family and was sighted and photographed in the second week of October.
- C) The field survey was initiated by the Bhattiyat Forest Range of the Dalhousie Forest Division of the Himachal Pradesh Forest Department in 2022.

China restricts Exports of Graphite

China has recently unveiled plans to restrict Exports of Graphite- a mineral crucial to the manufacture of batteries for electric vehicles (EV) on National Security grounds. The announcement comes just days after the US imposed additional limits on the kinds of Semiconductors that American Companies can sell to Chinese firms.

Key Points:

- A) The Institute for Energy Research at Washington DC, says that carmakers are trying to lock in supplies of graphite from sources outside of China.
- B) According to the International Energy Agency, the global sales of EVs including purely battery-powered vehicles and hybrids are soaring.
- C) China was the world's leading graphite producer last year, accounting for an estimated 65% of global production.

About Graphite:

- A) It is a type of crystal carbon.
- B) It is used in pencils, lubricants and crucibles.
- C) It is mined extensively in China, India and Brazil.


Key Points:
