# Union Minister inaugurated Utkela Airport





# Electric Tractor CSIR PRIMA ET 11 developed



# IPBES 10th Plenary held at Bonn, Germany

The 140+ members of the Intergovernmental Science-Policy Platform on Biodiversity and Ecosystem Services (IPBES) gathered at Bonn, Germany for the body's 10th Plenary. The meet will focus on an assessment report on "Invasive Alien Species and their Control". It is set to be released to the public on September 4, 2023.

## **Key Points:**

- A) Delegates at the Plenary would approve the text of the report that has taken 4 years to be developed by 86 leading experts from 49 countries.
- B) Invasive Alien Species are a key driver of biodiversity loss and they are targets under Kunming-Montreal Global Biodiversity Framework (GBF).
- C) The session will also focus on administrative issues.

### **About IPBES:**

- A) Stands for Intergovernmental Science-Policy Platform on Biodiversity and Ecosystem Services.
- B) It was founded on April 21, 2012.
- C) It is an Intergovernmental organisation established to improve the interface between science and Policy issues of biodiversity and ecosystem.
- D) It was founded by UNEP, UNDP and FAO.

# IPRC tested CE-20 cryogenic engine


Indian Space Research Organisation's Liquid Propulsion System Centre (IPRC) in Mahendragiri successfully tested the cryogenic rocket engine to be used in its Mission Gaganyaan. The engine is to be used in the upper stage of the Launch Vehicle Mark-3, it was tested in the IPRC for 720 seconds.

### **Key Points:**

- A) The test was conducted to confirm the engines capacity, thrust, endurance, heat resistance etc.
- B) The Cryogenic stage is technically a very complex system due to its use of propellants at extremely low temperatures.
- C) A Cryogenic rocket stage is more efficient and provides more thrust for every kilogram of propellant it burns.

## About CE-20 Cryogenic engine:

- A) Designed and developed by Liquid Propulsion Systems Centre, subsidiary of ISRO.
- B) It will power the Cryogenic Upper stage of the LVM3 Launch vehicle.
- C) It is the first Indian cryogenic engine to feature a gas generator cycle.

# Chandrayaan 3 confirms presence of Sulphur on Lunar surface


The Laser-induced Breakdown Spectroscopy (LIBS) instrument onboard Chandrayaan 3 rover confirms the presence of Sulphur on the Lunar surface. Preliminary evidence has unveiled the presence of Aluminium, Sulphur, Calcium, Iron, Chromium and Titanium.

### **Key Points:**

- A) Evidence of the presence of Sulphur can reveal insights into the formation and evolution of the moon.
- B) LIBS payload is developed at the Laboratory for Electro-Optics Systems, Bengaluru.
- C) Further measurements have revealed the presence of manganese, Silicon and Oxygen.

#### **About LIBS:**

- A) Stands for Laser- Induced Breakdown Spectroscopy
- B) It had made the first ever in-situ measurements of elemental composition of the Lunar surface near the South pole.
- C) The laser pulse generates extremely hot and localised plasma.

# India's new warship Mahendragiri to be launched in Mumbai

The wife of the Vice President will launch India's latest warship, Mahendragiri at Mazagon Dock Shipbuilders Limited, Mumbai. It is the seventh and last stealth frigate of Project 17A. A warship's launch marks a significant milestone in its construction.

### **Key Points:**

- A) Project 17A Frigates are a follow on to the Project 17 (Shivalik Class) frigates.
- B) The previous five warships under Project 17A were launched during 2019-22.
- C) The Frigate is named after a mountain peak in Eastern Ghats located in Odisha.

### **About Project 17A:**

- A) Launched by defence forces of India to construct stealth guided Missile frigates.
- B) Project 17 A ships have been designed in house by the Indian Navy's Warship Design Bureau WDB.
- C) The project was launched in December 2020.

# **Mutiny in Gabon**



# **New Leaf Insects discovered**

An international research team recently discovered seven previously unknown species of leaf insects also known as Walking Leaves. Walking Leaves also called Leaf Insects are Insects that look very similar to Leaves.

## **Key Points:**

- A) They feed on plants and typically inhabit densely vegetated areas.
- B) These Insects produce sexually with females laying eggs that often resemble seeds or plant structures
- C) The are found in Islands of Indian Ocean, mainland South Asia and SouthEast asia, Papua New Guinea and Australia.
- D) They measure roughly 28 to 100mm in body length
- E) Males tend to be smaller than females.
- F) The arms and legs of Walking Leaves can regenerate

# Pakistan beat Nepal at Asia cup 2023 opener

Pakistan crushed Nepal by a huge margin of 238 runs in the opening match of Asia cup. Pakistan scored a mammoth 342 runs for 6 wickets batting first. The opener was held at Multan in Pakistan where an opening ceremony of the event was also held.

- A) Shaheen Shah Afridi struck twice in the first over as Nepal were eventually bowled out for 104.
- B) Shadab Khan, the leg spinner of Pakistan took 4 wickets.
- C) Babar Azam scored 151 and Iftikhar Ahmed made an unbeaten 109, adding 214 runs for the fifth wicket.

### **About Asia Cup:**

- A) Officially known as ACC Men's Asia Cup.
- B) It is a men's International cricket tournament contested between Asian countries in either ONE day international or T20 format.
- C) Its first edition was held in UAE in 1984.
