Every year 5th September is celebrated as National teacher's day as the day commemorates Birth anniversary of Dr Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan.

Action Plan for startups unveiled

Under the Startup India Action Plan for startups unveiled to create a vibrant startup ecosystem in the country. In order to build a strong ecosystem for nurturing innovation, startups and encouraging private investments in the startup ecosystem of the country, the Government launched the Startup India initiative on 16th January 2016.

Key Points:

- A) Startup India is an initiative of the Government, not a scheme.
- B) The Action Plan comprises 19 action items spanning across areas such as Simplification and Handholding, Funding Support and incentives and Industry-Academia partnership and incubation.
- C) Government has notified the establishment of the Credit Guarantee Scheme for Startups (CGSS).
- D) Direct jobs created by the recognised startups over the last 3 years have increased.
- E) Government also facilitates participation and engagement of Indian Startups on International platforms.











PM Modi's visit to Jakarta

Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi will travel to Jakarta, capital of Indonesia at the invitation of Mr Joko Widodo, President of Republic of Indonesia. During the visit the PM will attend the 20th ASEAN-India Summit and 18th East Asia Summit being hosted by Indonesia as current chair of ASEAN.

- A) Forthcoming ASEAN-India Summit will be the first summit since the elevation of India-ASEAN relations to a comprehensive strategic partnership in 2022.
- B) The Summit will review the progress of India-ASEAN relations and chart the future direction of Cooperation.
- C) Views on issues of regional and global significance will be exchanged during the summit.

Singapore Indian origin ex minister Tharman Shanmugaratnam wins the Presidential election. He defeated two contenders of Chinese origin Ng Kok Song and Tan Kin Lian in the country's first contested presidential polls since 2011.

Key Points:

- A) He secured 70.4 percent of votes while the other two scored 15.7 and 13.88 percent.
- B) He joined politics in 2001 and promised the country to evolve the country's culture to keep it a shining spot in the world.
- C) He has served as Deputy Prime Minister from 2011 to 2019.

India's first Solar Mission ADITYA-L1 launched


ISRO launched India's first Solar Mission ADITYA-L1 on the Polar Satellite Launch Vehicle (PSLV-XL) from Sriharikota Launchpad. Union Minister Jitendra Singh termed it as India's Sunshine Moment. The Satellite was placed successfully into the intended orbit.

Key Points:

- A) India's first solar Observatory has begun its journey to the destination of Sun-Earth L1 Point.
- B) ADITYA-L1 is the first space based Indian Mission to study the Sun.
- C) The spacecraft shall be placed in a halo orbit around the Lagrange Point of the Sun-Earth system.

About PSLV:

- A) Stands for Polar Satellite Launch Vehicle.
- B) It is an expendable medium lift Launch vehicle designed and operated by ISRO.
- C) It is a 3rd generation Launch Vehicle.

DSC A20 launched at Titagarh, Kolkata

DSC A20, the first ship of the Five Diving Support Craft project was launched at Titagarh, Kolkata onto hooghly river. The launch ceremony was presided over by VAdm Sanjay Mahindru. Mrs Aradhna Mahindru launched the ship with invocation from Atharva Veda.

Key Points:

- A) These ships are designed to undertake operational/training diving operations in harbours and coastal waters
- B) They are 30 m long catamaran hull ships with a displacement of across 300 tons.
- C) All five DSC are anticipated to be delivered to the Indian Navy in 2024-25.

About Titagarh Rail Systems:

Genetic mapping of Kakapo


The genetic mapping of almost the entire kakapo population has shed new light on specific traits that will help conservation biologists in their efforts to save the Critically Endangered flightless night parrots. It will help New Zealand's rare night parrot survive.

Key Points:

- A) The genetic mapping will provide a blueprint for conservation of other Threatened species.
- B) Kakapo are remarkable and unusual birds found only in Aotearoa New Zealand.
- C) Kakapo suffer from diseases such as fungal infection Aspergillosis.

About Kakapo:

- A) It is a large, nocturnal, flightless, lek breeding parrot.
- B) It has a pale owl-like face and feet Grey with pale soles.
- C) They only breed every few years and many of their eggs are infertile.

Global Fund Secure deal to reduce HIV treatment price

The Global Fund announced a deal with generic pharmaceutical manufacturers to slash the price of cutting edge HIV drugs. The Global Fund is a partnership set up in 2002 to battle AIDS, tuberculosis and Malaria. It said that agreement would make it possible to provide the advanced pill known as TLD for under USD 45 per person.

Key Points:

- A) The improved pricing i.e. 25 percent reduction will.allow government in resource limited settings to expand access to critical HIV services.
- B) The three in one pill bands together the drugs tenofovir disoproxil fumarate, lamivudine and dolutegravir.
- C) The Global Fund along with UNAIDS, the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation and others partnered in 2017.

About Global Fund:

- A) It was founded on 28th January 2002.
- B) Its headquarters are located in Geneva, Switzerland.
- C) Its founders are Melinda French Gates, Bill gates, Kofi Annan, Jeffrey Sachs, Amir Attaran.

The Golden Arm of India and the newly crowned World Champion Neeraj Chopra finished second in Men's javelin event in Zurich Diamond League. The Indian star javelin thrower secured a throw of 85.71 m in his last attempt.

- A) Neeraj finished behind Czech Republic's Jakub Vadlejch who covered a distance of 85.86 m.
- B) With the throw Neeraj qualified for the Diamond League Final in Eugene.
- C) Neeraj Chopras winning streak came to an end with this result.


