20th ASEAN-India Summit in Jakarta

Prime Minister Narendra Modi attended the 20th ASEAN-India Summit and 18th East Asia in Jakarta. Extension discussions were held for further strengthening of ASEAN-India Comprehensive Strategic Partnership and charting its future course.

Key Points:

- A) PM reaffirmed ASEAN centrality in the Indo-Pacific and highlighted the synergies between India's Indo-Pacific Oceans Initiative (IPOI) and ASEANS Outlook on the Indo-Pacific (AOIP).
- B) He presented a 12 point proposal for strengthening India-ASEAN cooperation covering connectivity, digital transformation, trade and economic engagement.
- C) Two Joint statements one on Maritime Cooperation and the other on Food Security were adopted.

- A) Stands for East Asia Summit.
- B) Regional forum held annually by leaders.
- C) First summit was held in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia on 14 December 2005.



Contract for construction and delivery of Eleven Ammunition Barges was concluded with M/search Suryadipta Projects Pvt Ltd, Thane, a MSME in consonance with Atma Nirbhar Bharat initiatives of the Government of India.

REC Limited holds 54th AGM





Scheme titled VGF for Development of Battery Energy Storage Systems (BESS)

The Union Cabinet chaired by the Honourable Prime Minister approved the Scheme for Viability Gap Funding (VGF) for development of Battery Energy Storage Systems (BESS). The approved scheme envisages development of 4000 MWh of BESS projects by 2030-31 with a financial support of up to 40 percent of the capital cost as budgetary support in the form of VGF.

Key Points:

- A) Minimum of 85 percent of the BESS project capacity will be made available to Distribution Companies (DISCOMS).
- B) It will enhance the integration of renewable energy into the electricity grid but also minimise wastage while optimising the utilisation of transmission networks.
- C) The Government of India remains committed to promoting clean and green energy solutions.
- D) The selection of BESS developers for VGF grants will be carried out through a transparent competitive bidding process, promoting a level playing field for both Public and Private Sector entities.
- E) The VGF shall be disbursed in five tranches linked with the various stages of implementation of BESS projects.

White Sambar discovered in Cauvery WS


Researchers discovered rare leucistic sambar deer in the Cauvery Wildlife Sanctuary. The presence of a leucistic sambar has been documented in the Sangama Range of Cauvery Wildlife Sanctuary during studies carried out on leopards by conservation scientist Sanjay Gubbi and team

Key Points:

- A) The Female sambar deer was seen accompanying another adult female sambar.
- B) It is the first recorded photographic record of a white form of sambar from this landscape through a white form of sambar deer that was previously recorded in Bandipur Tiger Reserve in 2014.
- C) The sighting of white form of Sambar deer is an important natural history documentation for this area.

About Sambar Deer:

- A) Largest deer native to the Indian subcontinent.

- B) They help individuals achieve optimal physical function from basic mobility to complex activities.
- C) This year the World PT day focuses on arthritis, delving into various forms of inflammatory arthritis, such as rheumatoid Arthritis and axial spondyloarthritis.
- D) The Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities (DEPwD), under the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment serves as the central authority for advancing the development agenda of Persons with Disabilities in the country.
- E) This observance will entail conducting a range of events across the nation through affiliated institutions.

Dementia India Alliance (DIA), a Nonprofit, family carer-centred organisation launched a national dementia support line and an Online memory screening clinic DemClinic.


It will assist individuals and families facing the challenges of dementia, a neurodegenerative brain disease.

Key Points:

- B) It is the second railway station in the South Central Railway zone after Secunderabad to have bagged the Platinum rating.
- C) The IGBC developed the Green Railway Stations rating system to facilitate adoption of green concepts and enhance the overall experience.

Key Points:

- A) It is designed to showcase exemplary sustainable tourism practices, case studies and insights from G20 Nations that align with Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) within the Tourism sector.
- B) It was launched virtually and consolidates information from the G20 Tourism Working Group, including the GOA Roadmap, survey results and best practices from G20 countries.
- C) It is expected to serve as a collaborative knowledge sharing platform, guiding the global community towards more sustainable, resilient and inclusive tourism practices.

About SDG:

- A) Stands for Sustainable Development Goals, also known as Global Goals.
- B) It was adopted by the United Nations in 2015.
- C) It was adopted as a universal call to end poverty, protect the planet and ensure that by 2030 all people enjoy peace and prosperity.

The Indian Men's Table tennis Team signed off with a Bronze Medal after going down 0-3 to Chinese Taipei in the Asian Championships semifinal. At the Asian Championships, the Losing semifinalists are also awarded bronze medals.

Key Points:

- A) Sharath was handed a 6-11, 6-11, 9-11 defeat by Chuang Chih-Yuan ranked 26th.
- B) Sathiyan went down 5-11, 6-11, 10-12 to World number 7 Lin Yun Ju as the third seeded Indian team trailed 0-2.
- C) County's highest ranked player at 63, Harmeet lost to World number 33 of Chinese Taipei Kao Cheng Jui with 11-6, 11-7, 7-11, 11-9.


