21st Edition of India France Bilateral Naval Exercise VARUNA-2023



NPCI launched digital payments products



- B) The credit line on UPI is a game changer offering pre sanctioned credit lines via the UPI.It grants instant access to credit.

Israeli scientists create synthetic 14 day Human Embryo

Scientists at Weizmann Institute of Science have managed to create a synthetic human embryo model without using egg, sperm or womb, in a feat that could impact research on fertility, tissue growth and drug testing. Researchers created complete models of human embryos from stem cells cultured in a lab and grew them up to day 14.

Key Points:

- A) Model contains crucial cell types and structures, offering a powerful tool for studying early human development, organ formation and genetic diseases.
- B) The breakthrough could revolutionise IVF by offering insights into early human development.
- C) It sheds light on stem cell differentiation and self assembly processes advancing our knowledge of development biology.

About Weizmann Institute of Science:

- A) It is a public research university in Rehovot, Israel.
- B) It was established in 1934, 14 years before the state of Israel.
- C) Its founder was Chaim Weizmann.



Bird like Dinosaur discovered

Scientists unearthed the fossil of a Jurassic Period dinosaur named Fujianvenator Prodigiosus from Fujian province. It is a member of a grouping called Avialans that includes all birds and their closest non-avian relatives. Birds survived the Asteroid strike 66 million years ago that doomed their non-avian dinosaur comrades.

Key Points:

- A) Fujianvenators lower leg bone -the tibia- was twice as long as it's Thigh bone.
- B) Based on the anatomy of its long legs, the researchers proposed two possible lifestyles- either fast running or wading in a swampy environment.
- C) It was discovered last October and the fossil is fairly complete but lacks the animal's skull and parts of its feet.

About Jurassic Period:

- B) It extends from 201.3 million to 145 million years ago.



Wide Field Survey Telescope

China to launch Wide Field Survey Telescope with capability to pick faintest signals from space. The WFSTs core scientific objective is to explore and monitor dynamic astronomical events and conduct time domain astronomical observation research.

Key Points:

- A) It is characterised by a 2.5 metre primary mirror.
- B) It will be the Largest time-domain Survey facility in the Northern Hemisphere.
- C) It will enable researchers to detect faint and distant celestial signals including those from galaxies beyond the Milky Way and Galaxy clusters.
- D) The Telescope is located at the Lenghu Astronomical Observation base in Northwest China's Qinghai Province.
- E) The WFST project was launched in July 2019 through a collaboration between the University of Science and Technology of China and the Purple Mountain Observatory.

Presence of Clade 9 variant of Varicella-Zoster Virus (VZV)


Indian Council of Medical Research-National Institute of Virology scientists have for the first time discovered the presence of Clade 9 variant of Varicella-Zoster Virus (VZV). It is a herpes virus that causes Chickenpox, a common childhood illness.

Key Points:

- A) Herpes Zoster (HZ) commonly known as Shingles is caused by the reactivation of the Varicella Zoster Virus (VZV).
- B) The New study published recently in the recent issue of Annals of Medicine Journal has reported the circulation of VZV clade 9 in India.
- C) The Clade 9 is the most common strain in circulation in countries such as Germany, UK and USA.

About Chickenpox:

State Bank of India launched the RuPay NCMC Prepaid card to facilitate easy digital ticketing fare payments in metro, buses, water ferries, parking etc. through a single card. Individuals can also use the National Common Mobility Card for making retail and e-commerce payments.

Rohan Bopanna - Matthew Ebden Iose US open Finals




