Bharat becomes 13th country to issue OIML certificates


Bharat becomes the 13th country in the World that can issue Internationally accepted OIML (International Organisation of Legal Metrology) certificates. To sell a weight or measure in the International Market an OIML pattern approval certificate is mandatory.

Key Points:

- A) It will create a facility for International manufacturers to get their equipment tested in Bharat in turn Bharat will generate revenue and employment.
- B) Domestic Manufacturers can now get their weighing and measuring instruments tested in Bharat and sell in the International market.
- C) Bharat now joins an exclusive group of nations including Australia, Switzerland, China, Czech Republic, Germany, Denmark, France, UK, Japan, Netherlands, Sweden and Slovakia.

About OIML:

- A) Stands for International Organisation for Legal Metrology.
- B) It is an International Organisation established in 1955.
- C) Bharat became its member in 1956.

Supreme Court under National Judicial Data Grid platform



55th Network Planning Group Meeting under PM GatiShakti


The 55th Network Planning Group(NPG) meeting held under the chairmanship of Special Secretary Logistics, DPIIT, Smt. Sumita Dawra recommended six infrastructure projects under PM Gatishakti. Six projects including three projects of the Ministry of Railways and 3 projects of MoRTH were assessed.

Key Points:

- A) A total of 106 projects with a total value of Rs 11 lakh crore assessed by Network Planning Group till date.
- B) The Railway projects are expected to reduce the overall logistics cost by providing shorter routes and reducing the traffic congestion on existing Railway lines.
- C) These projects will help in socio-economic uplifting of the region.





First C-295 Aircraft

The Indian Air Force took the delivery of its first C-295 transport aircraft from Airbus Defence and Space in Spain. The aircraft is the first of the 56 such planes ordered by IAF under a Rupees 21,935 crore project to modernise its Transport fleet.

Key Points:

- A) C-295 is a state of art aircraft capable of missions like special operations, disaster response and Maritime patrol.
- B) The aircraft is expected to be formally inducted into service at a ceremony in Hindon.
- C) 16 aircraft out of 56 will be manufactured in Spain while 40 will be produced through a joint venture between Tata and Airbus in Gujarat.
- D) The remaining 15 aircraft to be built in Spain will be delivered by 2024.
- E) India will become a potential exporter of C-295 aircraft in the future.

Green Tribunal bans Motorboats in Bhoj Wetland


The National Green Tribunal (NGT) recently ordered the Madhya Pradesh Government to stop the operation of Cruise vessels as well as other motor propelled boats in the Bhoj Wetland. The order came after environmentalist Subhash Pandey approached the Tribunal.

- A) The Wetland is also a Ramsar site with international importance and has two important lakes called Bhojtal and Chota Talab.
- B) The Tribunal said no permanent construction will be allowed within the Zone of Influence of wetlands.
- C) More than 2500 migratory birds from across the world come regularly to this Wetland.

About Bhoj Wetland:

- A) Human Made reservoir in the city of Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh.
- B) Designated as a Ramsar site in 2002.
- C) It is rich in biodiversity particularly for macrophytes, phytoplankton and zooplankton.

Indigenous Communication-based train Control (i-CBTC) system



1st MotoGP Bharat Grand Prix to be held at BIC Greater Noida




