Swachhta HI Seva 2023 launched



DAC approves Nine capital Acquisition proposals for Armed Forces


Defence Acquisition Council (DAC) approves Acceptance of Necessity (AoN) for nine capital acquisitions proposals worth 45000 crore. It is a boost to Atmanirbharta in Defence.

Key Points:

- A) All the procurements will be made from Indian Vendors under Buy IDMM (Indigenously Designed Developed and Manufactured) category.
- B) DAC accorded the AoN for procurement of Light Armoured Multipurpose Vehicles and Integrated Surveillance and Targeting System.
- C) DAC also approved procurement of Next Generation Survey Vessels for the Indian Navy.

About DAC:

- A) Stands for Defence Acquisition Council.
- B) Highest decision making body in the Defence Ministry for deciding new policies and capital acquisitions.
- C) It was formed in 2001 after the Kargil War.



PM to launch PM Vishwakarma Scheme

Prime Minister Narendra Modi on the occasion of Vishwakarma Jayanti will launch a new scheme named "PM Vishwakarma" at India International Convention and Expo Centre. It will be launched for traditional artisans and craftspeople of the nation.

Key Points:

- A) Scheme draws inspiration from PMs vision to support and Skill the people engaged in traditional crafts.
- B) It will be a fully funded Central Sector Scheme with an outlay of 13000 crore.
- C) Schemes aim to strengthen and nurture the Guru-Shishya Parampara or family based practice of traditional skills by Vishwakarmas working with their hands and tools.
- D) Under the scheme the Vishwakarmas will be registered free of charge through the Common Services Centre using the Biometrics based PM Vishwakarma portal.
- E) Eighteen Traditional crafts will be covered under PM Vishwakarma.

- A) It will be compulsory for states to register Births and Deaths on the Centre's Civil Registration System (CRS) portal and share data with the Registrar General of India.
- B) Birth Certificate will now be considered as a single document for availing several crucial services including admissions to educational institutions, issuance of driving licence, preparation of voters list etc.
- C) Earlier there was a requirement for certain persons to report Births and Deaths to the Registrar.

About RGI:

- A) Stands for Registrar General of India.
- B) It was formed in 1961.
- C) Its work is to arrange, conduct and analyse the results of demographic surveys of India including Census of India and linguistic Survey of India.





Unified Portal for Agricultural Statistics (UPAg)



Bangladesh beat India for the first time in Asia Cup




