India Initiates 'Operation Brahma' to Assist Earthquake-Affected Myanmar

On March 29, 2025, Prime Minister Modi assured Myanmar's Senior General Min Aung Hlaing of India's humanitarian aid after a devastating earthquake. India launched 'Operation Brahma', deploying relief teams, aircraft with supplies, and setting up a field hospital. The Ministry of External Affairs confirmed no Indian casualties. Challenges include Myanmar's political divisions, complicating aid distribution. As the death toll rises, India has committed long-term support, including more aid, medical teams, and reconstruction assistance.

Government schemes like Ayushman Bharat, PMGKAY, eShram, and Atal Pension Yojana have significantly reduced poverty. Over 24.8 crore people escaped multidimensional poverty in the last decade. India launched a Social Protection Data Pooling Exercise to improve coverage accuracy. The Ministry of Labour & Employment collaborates with the ILO to include housing and food security in global welfare indicators.

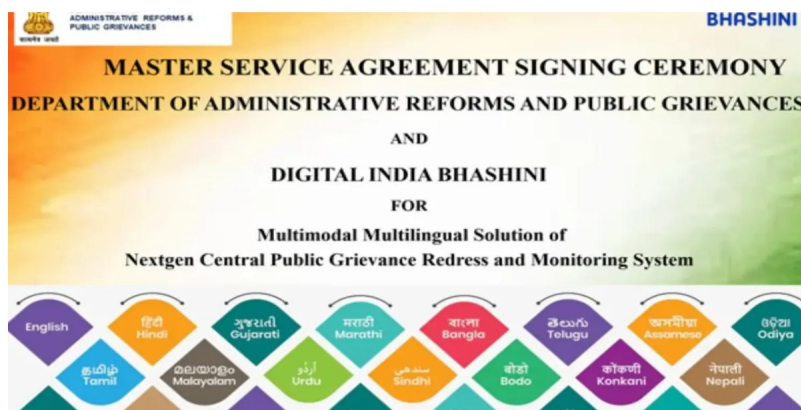
