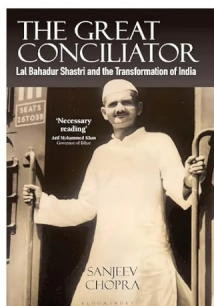

SpaceX Launches Fram2 Mission, First Humans to Fly Over Earth's Poles

SpaceX's Fram2 mission successfully launched, marking the first human spaceflight to travel over Earth's poles. The mission, led by entrepreneur Chun Wang and an all-civilian crew, aims to orbit the Earth from pole to pole, providing valuable data for long-duration space exploration. The crew, aboard the Crew Dragon Resilience, will conduct 22 experiments, including the first x-ray in space and growing mushrooms in microgravity. The mission, lasting four days, will offer unique views of Earth's polar regions and contribute to human health research in space.
