Poonam Gupta Named RBI Deputy Governor Before MPC Meeting

The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has appointed Poonam Gupta as Deputy Governor for a three-year term, replacing Michael Patra. Gupta, formerly a World Bank economist, currently serves as Director General at the National Council of Applied Economic Research (NCAER). She is also a member of the Economic Advisory Council to the Prime Minister and the Convener for the Advisory Council to the 16th Finance Commission. Her appointment comes ahead of the RBI's Monetary Policy Committee meeting scheduled for April 7-9, 2025.

Swaminathan S. Iyer Appointed as Whole-Time Member (Life) of the IRDAI

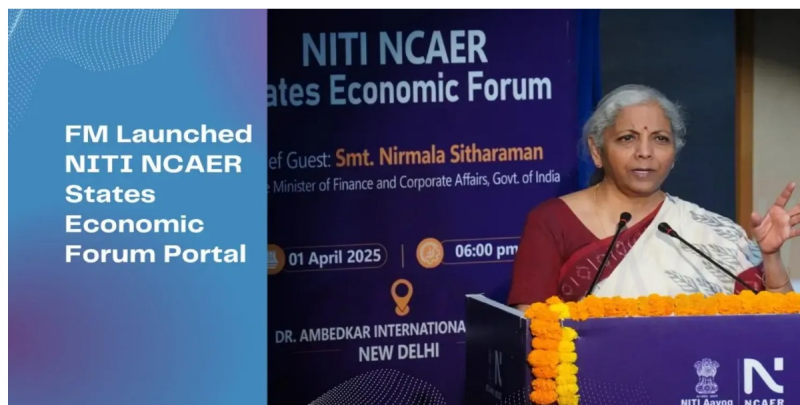

The RBI reports that 98.21% of Rs 2000 banknotes have been returned to the banking system

The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has announced that 98.21% of Rs 2000 banknotes have been returned to the banking system after the withdrawal announcement in May 2023. At that time, Rs 2000 notes in circulation were valued at 3.56 lakh crore, which has now decreased to 6,366 crore as of March 31, 2025. The deposit and exchange facility for these notes was available at bank branches until October 7, 2023, and remains accessible at 19 RBI offices. Rs 2000 notes continue to be legal tender.

India Sees Record Number of Child Adoptions in 12 Years

In FY 2024-25, India recorded 4,515 child adoptions, the highest in 12 years, with 4,155 being domestic adoptions.
