Francesco Bagnaia won the Grand Prix of the Americas after Marc Marquez crashed out on lap nine. The race at Circuit of the Americas saw Ducati dominate, with Alex Marquez finishing second and Fabio Di Giannantonio third. Bagnaia climbed from sixth to victory, marking Ducati's 20th consecutive Grand Prix win, nearing Honda's record of 22. Marquez, who led early, crashed after touching a kerb. Alex Marquez now surpasses his brother Marc in the riders' standings by one point.

## India Wraps Up Senior Asian Wrestling Championship with 10 Medals

India concluded its campaign at the 2025 Senior Asian Wrestling Championship in Amman with 10 medals. Manisha Bhanwala won gold (62kg), while Reetika Hooda (76kg), Udit (61kg), and Deepak Punia (92kg) secured silver. Six wrestlers, including Antim Pangal (53kg) and Dinesh (125kg), claimed bronze. The 30-member Indian team showcased strong performances in freestyle and Greco-Roman wrestling. Governed by United World Wrestling (UWW), the championship highlighted India's rising talent and continental dominance in the sport.
