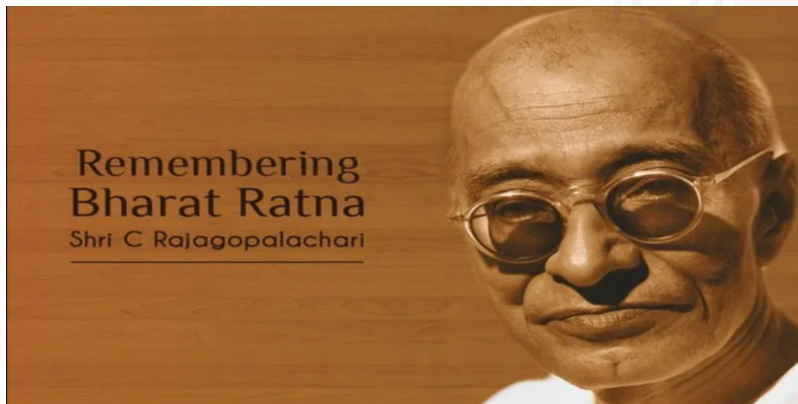

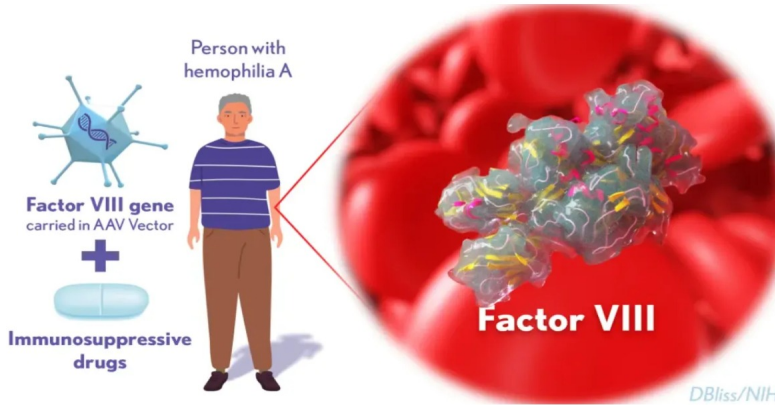

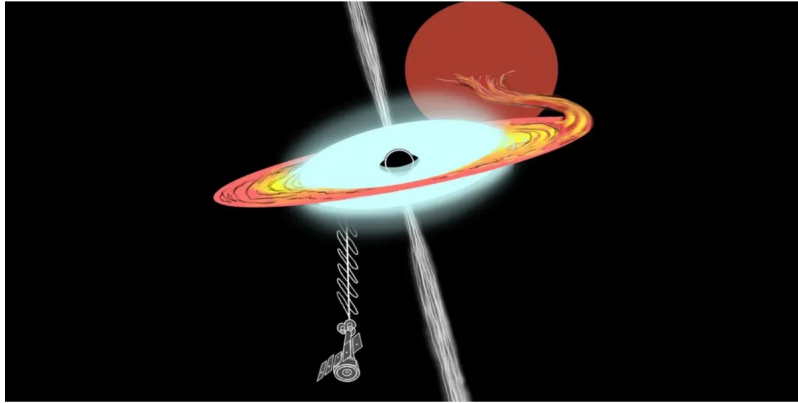

NASAs IXPE probes exotic X-ray Binary system

The NASA's Imaging X-ray Polarimetry Explorer (IXPE) has recently unveiled structures in a newly discovered X-ray Binary system designated as Swift J1727. The observatory has unraveled the processes of a binary black hole system. IXPE is a small exploration mission of NASA in collaboration with Italian Space Agency (ASI). It was launched in 2021 and it is the first mission of NASA to study the polarization of X-ray from many different types of celestial objects.
