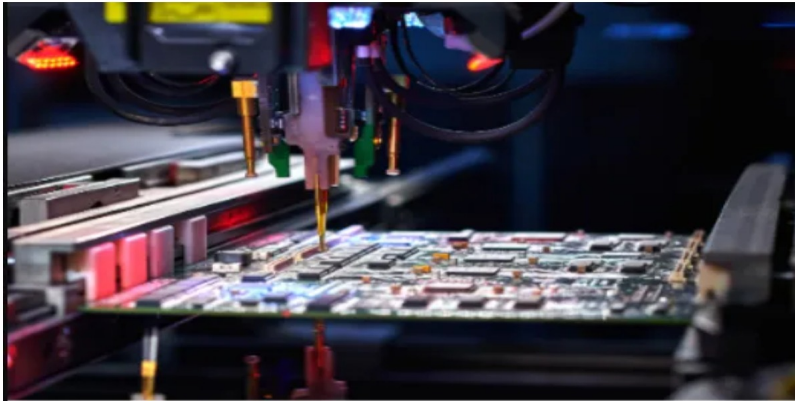

The Search and Rescue Aid Tool (SARAT) aimed at enhancing the effectiveness of sea rescue operations was recently upgraded by the Indian National Centre for Ocean Information Services (INCOIS). It was introduced for the first time in 2016 aiding the Indian Coast Guard in search operations. The 2.0 version of SARAT includes enhanced visuals and colour coded search regions and utilises high resolution Ocean current data to model drift accurately.
