India-Singapore Artillery Exercise Concludes Successfully

The 13th edition of the Joint Military Exercise AGNI WARRIOR (XAW-2024) between the Indian Army and Singapore Armed Forces concluded on November 30, 2024, at Devlali, Maharashtra. Held from November 28-30, the exercise involved 182 personnel from the Singapore Artillery and 114 from the Indian Army. The focus was on joint firepower planning, execution, and use of advanced equipment. The exercise aimed to enhance mutual understanding and coordination between both forces.

Dragonfly Mission Aims to Study Titan

NASA's Dragonfly mission, launching in 2028, aims to explore Saturn's moon Titan using a rotorcraft lander. SpaceX has been chosen to handle the launch, valued at \$256.6 million. The mission will collect samples and analyse surface compositions to study Titan's habitability and prebiotic chemistry. The launch is scheduled between July 5-25, 2028, aboard a SpaceX Falcon Heavy rocket from NASA's Kennedy Space Center.

India Rises to 49th in NRI 2024

India has improved its ranking by 11 places, securing the 49th position globally in the Network Readiness Index 2024, with a score increase from 49.93 in 2023 to 53.63. The country leads in areas like AI, FTTH internet subscriptions, and mobile broadband traffic. India ranks first in AI scientific publications and talent concentration. The country's digital progress is evident, with improvements in telecommunication infrastructure, 5G services, and rising internet subscribers. India aims to lead in next-gen telecom technologies through Bharat 6G Vision.

Uttar Pradesh Police Stations to Go Paperless

Kannauj is set to become the first district in Uttar Pradesh to implement a fully paperless e-office system by the end of December 2024. This digital transition will streamline administrative functions, eliminating the need for physical files. Superintendent of Police Amit Kumar Anand launched the initiative, distributing laptops to officers and conducting training at the District Training Centre. The e-office system, developed by NIC, will be fully operational in all police stations.

NTPC and Eskom Strengthen Power Sector Ties

India will provide Eskom with a Power plant control room simulator as part of a collaboration to modernize and repurpose South Africa's power stations. This initiative follows a MoU between NTPC and Eskom, focusing on renewable energy, emission reduction, and maintaining efficient coal operations. The announcement came after Indian energy companies met Eskom executives at the Urja Matla Energy Conference. India aims to equip Eskom with advanced technologies for system efficiency.



Cyclone Fengal Hits Tamil Nadu Coast

Cyclone Fengal, named by Saudi Arabia, made a delayed landfall near Puducherry, causing heavy rainfall and squally weather over Tamil Nadu's coastal belt. With winds of 70-80 km/hr, gusting to 90 km/hr, the storm caused rough conditions in north Tamil Nadu and Puducherry. The cyclone formed from evaporated seawater, strengthening over water and weakening over land, causing rain, strong winds, and storm surges. Chennai airport shut, and rain-related incidents occurred in the city.


