Ratapani Wildlife Sanctuary declared as Madhya Pradesh's 8th Tiger Reserve

The Madhya Pradesh Chief Minister Dr Mohan Yadav officially notified the Ratapani Wildlife Sanctuary as the State's 8th Tiger Reserve with an estimated population of 90 tigers. The Sanctuary is situated across Raisen and Sehore districts. The Sanctuary received in-principle approval from NTCA 2008 to be declared as a Tiger Reserve. There are 56 protected areas designated as Tiger Reserves as of December 2024.

Red Breasted Flycatcher found in Ameenpur Lake

The Red Breasted Flycatcher scientifically named as Ficedula Parva was recently spotted in Ameenpur Lake in Hyderabad. It is a small passerine bird that migrates from Eastern Europe to escape the harsh winter. Its IUCN Conservation status is Least Concern and it breeds from spring to summer in deciduous mixed forests of Eastern Europe and across Central Asia. Its characteristic feature is a reddish orange throat that extends till the upper breast.

Varkala Cliff

The National Geo-Heritage site Varkala Cliff was recently in news due to its deteriorating condition. The National Green Tribunal has sought a reply from the Geological Survey of India and others about its deteriorating condition. It is located in Varkala, a coastal town in Thiruvananthapuram, Kerala and it exposes the sedimentary rock formation of the Mio-Pliocene age. It is designated as the 27th National Geological Monument in the country.

Russia to replace older missiles with Satan 2

The older missiles are set to be replaced by the RS-28 Sarmat Intercontinental Ballistic Missiles by the Russian Army. RS-28 Sarmat is a liquid-fueled intercontinental ballistic missile also known as Satan 2. The missile has a range of 18000 km and can carry a 10-ton payload. The missile can load upto 10 heavy nuclear warheads and it is designated as Heavy ICBM.

Isolated case of Japanese Encephalitis reported in National Capital

An isolated case of Japanese Encephalitis was recently reported in the National Capital Delhi. It is a severe viral zoonotic disease caused by Japanese Encephalitis (B) virus and is transmitted from animals to humans by the Culex mosquito of the Vishnui group. There is no specific antiviral treatment for the virus and Vaccination is the most effective prevention strategy. Its symptoms include vomiting, headache and neurological issues and it is not transmitted from humans to humans.

1750 crores approved for Tato-1 Hydroelectric Project

An investment amount of 1750 crores was recently approved by the Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs (CCEA) for the Tato-1 Hydro Electric Project (HEP). The Tato-1 Hydroelectric Project will have an installed capacity of 186 MW (3*62 MW) and it will be located in Shi Yomi district of Arunachal Pradesh. The project will be developed through a joint venture between the North Eastern Electric Power Corporation Ltd (NEEPCO) and Arunachal Pradesh Government.


