#### International Advisory Body for Submarine Cable Resilience



#### Anna Chakra and SCAN portal launched



#### Punatsangchhu-II Hydropower Project

The 1020 MW Punatsangchhu-II Hydropower Project nears completion in the Wangdue Phodrang district of Bhutan. The project is developed by the Punatsangchhu-II Hydropower Project Authority under an intergovernmental agreement between the Government of India and the Royal Government of Bhutan. It is a 1 GW run of the river hydroelectric power generating facility and is funded by the Government of India with 30% grant and 70% loan.

### Bharatiya Vayuyan Vidheyak 2024

The Bharatiya Vayuyan Vidheyak 2024 was recently passed by the Lok Sabha after clearance by the Rajya Sabha in August 2024. The new bill replaces the outdated Aircraft Act, 1934 with the aim to overhaul India's Aviation laws. The new legislation promotes ease of doing business in the aviation sector. One of the characteristic features of the bill is that it established three authorities namely DGCA for regulatory functions, Bureau of Civil Aviation Security (BCAS) for security oversight and Aircraft Accidents Investigation Bureau (AAIB).
