Reliance Surpasses Apple, Secures 2nd Spot in FutureBrand 2024 Ranking

Reliance Industries Limited (RIL) secured the second position in the FutureBrand Index 2024, outperforming major global brands like Apple and Nike. This marks a significant rise from its 13th rank in 2023, showcasing RIL's strong brand presence and strategic expansion in energy, telecommunications, and retail. The FutureBrand Index assesses the top 100 global companies based on brand perception rather than financial performance. Notably, Samsung claimed the top position in this year's rankings.

Mumbai Cricket's Encyclopedia Dies at 76

Former Mumbai cricket captain and selector Milind Rege passed away at 76 due to a heart attack. He played 52 first-class matches, taking 126 wickets and scoring 1,532 runs. A key figure in Mumbai cricket, he was instrumental in selecting Sachin Tendulkar for the Ranji Trophy in 1988. Tributes poured in from cricketing legends like Tendulkar and Ravi Shastri, recognizing his talent-spotting ability and mentorship. The Mumbai team honored him with a black armband and a moment of silence.

Reliance Acquires 10 GWh Battery Capacity Under PLI Scheme

Reliance New Energy Battery Ltd, a subsidiary of RIL, secured a 10 GWh battery cell manufacturing capacity under India's ₹18,100 crore PLI ACC scheme. This agreement is part of the National Programme on Advanced Chemistry Cell (ACC) Battery Storage, aiming for a total 50 GWh capacity. With RIL's inclusion, the cumulative awarded capacity has reached 40 GWh. Following the announcement, RIL's stock rebounded after an initial decline. The company is committed to achieving net carbon zero by 2035 through its New Energy initiatives.

Shivraj Singh Chouhan to Unveil NAKSHA for Urban Land Survey

Union Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan inaugurated the NAKSHA pilot program on February 18, 2025, at Raisen, Madhya Pradesh. Led by the Ministry of Rural Development, it aims to modernize urban land surveys across 152 Urban Local Bodies in 26 states and 3 UTs. The initiative leverages IT-based systems, aerial surveys, and GIS technology for accurate land records. The Survey of India serves as the technical partner, while MPSEDC develops the web-GIS platform. The ₹194 crore project is fully funded by the central government.

India and Qatar Aim to Double Trade by 2030

India and Qatar have upgraded their bilateral relationship to a strategic partnership, with a commitment to double trade to nearly 30 billion dollars by 2030. Prime Minister Narendra Modi and Qatari Amir Sheikh Tamim bin Hamad Al-Thani discussed enhancing cooperation in trade, energy, technology, healthcare, and infrastructure. Qatar has pledged 10 billion dollars in investments in India. Agreements were signed on economic cooperation, taxation, and youth affairs. The visit also marked a reset in ties following the release of Indian Navy veterans detained in Qatar.

Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana Completes Nine Years

The Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana (PMFBY) will celebrate its ninth anniversary on February 18, 2025. Launched in 2016, the scheme provides crop insurance to farmers to protect them against natural calamities, pests and diseases. The scheme ensures affordable premiums, timely compensation and technology-driven loss assessment using satellite imagery, drones and AI. The government has extended PMFBY and RWBCIS till 2025-26 with a budget of ₹69,515.71 crore.
