Amit Shah Inaugurates Bharatiya Bhasha Anubhag to Advance Use of Indian Languages in Governance

On June 6, 2025, Union Home Minister Amit Shah inaugurated the Bharatiya Bhasha Anubhag (BBA) in New Delhi to promote Indian languages in governance. Aiming to reduce the dominance of English, the initiative supports communication and decision-making in regional languages. Backed by Rs. 56 crore in the Union Budget 2024-25, the BBA aligns with the NEP 2020 and will use C-DAC technology for real-time translations. It seeks to foster inclusivity, linguistic pride, and equitable governance across India's diverse language communities.

Magnus Carlsen Secures Norway Chess 2025 Title Following Thrilling Final Round Victory

Magnus Carlsen won the Norway Chess 2025 title for a record seventh time after a tense final round in Stavanger. Despite a challenging position, he secured a draw against Arjun Erigaisi, finishing with 16 points. Indian teen D Gukesh, in close contention, blundered against Fabiano Caruana and ended third. Caruana took second place with 15.5 points. The event showcased top global talents and rising stars, affirming Carlsen's dominance and Gukesh's growing status in elite chess.

Starlink Receives Approval to Launch Satellite-Based Internet Services in India

Elon Musk's Starlink has secured the Global Mobile Personal Communication by Satellite (GMPCS) licence from India's Department of Telecommunications, becoming the third company authorised to offer satellite internet in India after OneWeb and Jio. Starlink will receive trial spectrum within 15–20 days to demonstrate compliance with security and technical norms before full operations begin. This move enhances India's satellite communication sector, supports rural connectivity, promotes digital inclusion, and fosters competition and innovation in the internet services market.

Kerala's Public Health Laboratory has developed molecular test kits to detect a deadly amoeba

Kerala's State Public Health Laboratory has developed PCR-based molecular test kits to detect five deadly free-living amoeba species causing amoebic meningoencephalitis. For the first time, *Acanthamoeba* spp. was confirmed in a human cerebrospinal fluid sample locally, enabling early and accurate diagnosis. This breakthrough reduces dependency on external labs, speeds up treatment, and improves patient survival. It also supports targeted drug therapy and environmental monitoring, addressing the frequent amoebic encephalitis cases in Kerala more effectively.

Udhampur-Srinagar-Baramulla Rail Link Becomes Fully Operational After 28 Years

The Udhampur-Srinagar-Baramulla Rail Link (USBRL), a 272-km strategic railway project started in 1997, became fully operational on June 6, 2025, with the inauguration of the Sangaldan-Katra section by PM Modi. The project features engineering marvels like the world's highest Chenab Bridge and India's longest Pir Panjal Tunnel. It ensures all-weather connectivity between Jammu and Kashmir Valley, enhances defence logistics, boosts tourism and trade, and strengthens socio-economic integration in the region.

An 800-year-old Shiva temple from the Pandya era has been discovered in Tamil Nadu

An 800-year-old Shiva temple foundation from the later Pandya period was discovered in Udampatti village, Tamil Nadu, with inscriptions dating to 1217-1218 CE during Maravarman Sundara Pandya's reign. Named Thennavanisvaram, the temple was financially independent, supported by land and waterbody sales recorded in the inscriptions. This find sheds light on temple administration, land ownership, and royal patronage in the Pandya era. It also reveals the village's ancient name, Attur, enriching Tamil historical research.

PM Modi to Participate in G-7 Summit in Canada, Indicating Improvement in Bilateral Relations

Prime Minister Narendra Modi will visit Canada next week to attend the G-7 Summit in Alberta, marking his first visit in a decade. Invited by Canadian Prime Minister Mark Carney, the trip aims to reset strained India-Canada relations following tensions over the Khalistan issue, Nijjar's killing, and diplomatic expulsions. The leaders emphasised renewed cooperation and shared ties. Modi is also set to engage with global leaders, signalling a diplomatic thaw and potential restoration of High Commissioners between the two nations.
