Bangalore City University to Be Renamed in Honor of Dr. Manmohan Singh

Additionally, a new VTU constituent college will be established in Chintamani with Rs. 150 crore funding.

The 2025 Glass-Ceiling Index shows Sweden has regained its position as the best country for working women, surpassing Iceland. Despite global improvements, countries like Japan, Turkey, and South Korea still face challenges due to societal norms and wage gaps. Women's parliamentary representation rose globally to 34 percent, with corporate board participation at 33 percent, though gender disparities persist in wages and career advancement.




GLASS-CEILING INDEX 2025

The Sea Dragon 2025 naval exercise, held from March 4-19 off the Guam coast, involves the Indian Navy, Japan Maritime Self-Defence Force, Royal Australian Air Force, and the Republic of Korea Navy. This anti-submarine warfare drill enhances tactical coordination and maritime security in the Indo-Pacific region. Participants conduct submarine detection training, culminating in a live submarine hunt. The exercise strengthens military cooperation, particularly among Quad nations, and enhances India's ASW capabilities, promoting regional stability and defense collaboration.




