Tamil Nadu Govt Substitutes Rupee Symbol with Tamil Letter

The Tamil Nadu government replaced the rupee symbol with the Tamil letter 'ரூ' in its 2025-26 budget logo, sparking a language debate. While the English version retains the rupee symbol, the Tamil version uses Tamil letter. The BJP criticized the move, calling it anti-national, while the DMK defended it as a promotion of Tamil identity. CM Stalin also opposed the National Education Policy, calling it a tool for Hindi imposition. The controversy reflects ongoing tensions between regional and national language policies in India.

India's Involvement in the 69th UNCSW Session

India reaffirmed its commitment to gender equality at the 69th UN Commission on the Status of Women (UNCSW) in New York. Led by Union Minister Annpurna Devi, India emphasized progress in women's empowerment through key initiatives in health, education, and economic opportunities. The minister highlighted India's dedication to implementing the Beijing Declaration's goals and ensuring women's rights. The session, attended by global leaders, continues until March 21, 2025, focusing on gender equality and sustainable development challenges worldwide.

India's Industrial Production Index (IIP) Grows by 5.0 percent in January 2025

India's Index of Industrial Production (IIP) grew by 5.0 percent in January 2025, up from 3.2 percent in December 2024. Sector-wise, Mining grew by 4.4 percent, Manufacturing by 5.5 percent, and Electricity by 2.4 percent. Notable growth was seen in basic metals, petroleum products, and electrical equipment. Use-based classification showed growth across Primary Goods (5.5 percent), Capital Goods (7.8 percent), and Infrastructure Goods (7.0 percent), while Consumer Non-Durables declined by 0.2 percent. The IIP for February 2025 will be released on April 11, 2025.



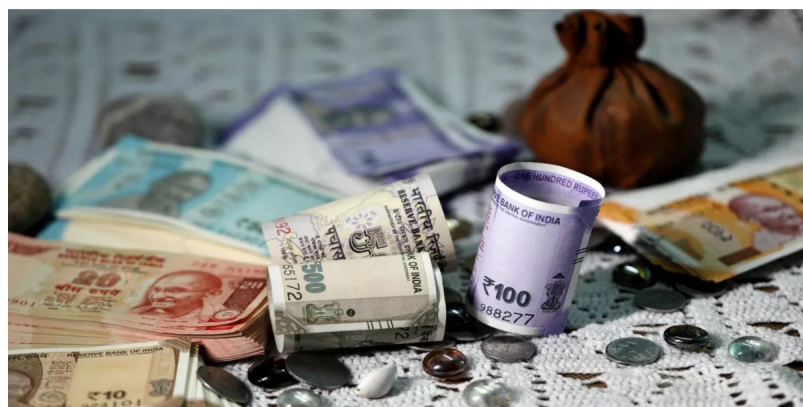

Finance Ministry Announces Zero Coupon Bond (ZCB) for Power Finance Corporation

The Finance Ministry has notified a 10-year Zero Coupon Bond (ZCB) for Power Finance Corporation, allowing it to raise 10,000 crore rupees. The bond, issued at 50,454 rupees with a face value of 1 lakh rupees, matures in 121 months. It offers fixed returns with no periodic interest, making it ideal for long-term investors. These bonds carry interest rate and duration risks but provide portfolio diversification. Tax applies only on gains, with long-term capital gains taxed at 12.5 percent. Issuance will be completed by March 31, 2027.

PM-YUVA 3.0, Prime Minister's Mentorship Program for Young Authors

The Ministry of Education launched PM-YUVA 3.0 on March 11, 2025, to mentor young authors (under 30) and promote reading, writing, and Indian literature globally. The scheme focuses on three themes: Indian Diaspora's Contribution, Indian Knowledge System, and Makers of Modern India (1950 to 2025). 50 authors will be selected via an All India Contest (March 11 to April 10, 2025). Selected authors will receive mentorship and training, with their books published by National Book Trust, India. A National Camp will be held during New Delhi World Book Fair 2026.

India's Participation in the 4th No Money for Terror (NMFT) Conference

India participated in the 4th 'No Money for Terror' (NMFT) Conference in Munich, emphasizing global unity against terror financing. India highlighted cross-border financial threats and evolving digital methods used by terrorists. Strengthened legal frameworks, intelligence networks, and initiatives like the Terror Funding and Fake Currency (TFFC) Cell, FIU-IND, and National Intelligence Grid (NATGRID) aim to counteract these risks. The inclusion of Virtual Digital Asset Service Providers under PMLA 2002 enhances monitoring. India's efforts have improved intelligence-sharing and enforcement measures.
