## Armenia and Azerbaijan Sign Peace Treaty to End 40-Year Conflict

On March 13, 2025, Armenia and Azerbaijan agreed on a peace treaty, ending nearly four decades of conflict over Nagorno-Karabakh. While the agreement marks progress toward stability, Azerbaijan insists on constitutional changes in Armenia before signing, causing uncertainty. Both sides have approved the treaty draft, but Armenia's constitution must be amended through a referendum. The agreement also affects third-party military presence, including EU monitors and Russian border guards, while both nations aim to demilitarise their shared border.



## India has earned USD 143 million by launching foreign satellites since 2015

India has become a global space leader, earning USD 143 million in foreign exchange by launching 393 foreign satellites from 34 countries between 2015 and 2024. The Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) used PSLV, LVM3, and SSLV vehicles for these launches. India has signed space cooperation agreements with 61 countries and advanced missions like Chandrayaan-3, Aditya L1, and Gaganyaan. The private space sector is also growing rapidly, contributing to innovation and technology development in India's space endeavours.
