## **Hydrologist Günter Blöschl has been awarded the 2025 Stockholm Water Prize**

Günter Blöschl, a professor at the Vienna University of Technology, has been awarded the 2025 Stockholm Water Prize for his pioneering research in flood hydrology. His work on flood risk analysis and climate change has significantly improved global flood prediction models. Blöschl developed a comprehensive database on flood risks and highlighted the link between climate change and increased flood frequency. The award will be presented by King Carl XVI Gustaf of Sweden during World Water Week in August 2025.

## **Japan becomes the first team to qualify for the 2026 FIFA World Cup**

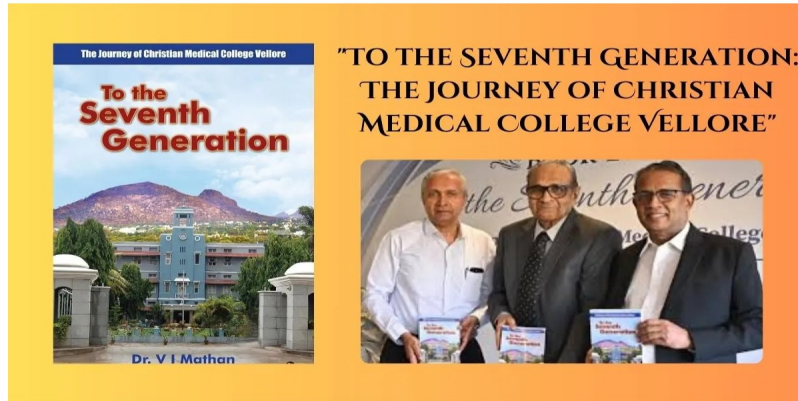
Japan secured its spot in the 2026 FIFA World Cup with a 2-0 win over Bahrain on March 20, 2025, at Saitama Stadium, marking its eighth consecutive World Cup appearance. Goals by Daichi Kamada and Takefusa Kubo sealed the victory. Coach Hajime Moriyasu emphasized the need for continued improvement. In other qualifiers, Australia defeated Indonesia 5-1, while South Korea drew 1-1 with Oman, maintaining their lead in Group B. The top two teams from each group directly qualify for the World Cup.
