# Brandon Holt Claims the 2025 Bengaluru Open ATP 125 Challenger Title

Brandon Holt won the 2025 Bengaluru Open ATP 125 Challenger title by defeating Shintaro Mochizuki 6-3, 6-3 in the singles final. Holt claimed \$28,400 and 125 ATP points for his victory. In the doubles category, Anirudh Chandrasekar (India) and Ray Ho (Taiwan) triumphed over Blake Bayldon and Matthew Romios (Australia) with a 6-2, 6-4 scoreline. This was Chandrasekar's sixth ATP Challenger title. The event was the final ATP Challenger tournament in India for 2025.

## Crisil Projects India's GDP Growth at 6.5% for FY26

Crisil forecasts India's GDP growth to remain steady at 6.5% for FY26, similar to the pre-pandemic average. This growth projection is based on assumptions of a normal monsoon, stable commodity prices, and improved private consumption and investment. The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) is expected to cut the repo rate by 50-75 basis points to support economic growth. Key factors influencing growth include private consumption recovery, investment growth, and external trade dynamics, with exports facing potential challenges.

## IRCTC and IRFC Upgraded to Navratna

The Indian government granted Navratna status to IRCTC and IRFC on March 4, 2025, enhancing their operational flexibility and investment autonomy. With this, all seven listed railway PSUs now hold Navratna status. IRCTC, responsible for ticketing and catering, and IRFC, managing railway infrastructure funding, join the ranks of top-performing PSUs. This upgrade allows them greater financial independence, including the ability to invest up to Rs.1,000 crore without government approval. The move reflects the government's focus on improving the efficiency and profitability of railway enterprises.

Heavy snowfall between February 25-28 has made the region ideal for winter sports. The event will feature alpine skiing, snowboarding, and more, with 30 teams and about 1,000 athletes participating. Kashmir's recent weather conditions include moderate rain and snow, with risks of landslides and rockfalls. Temperatures across the region have dropped, with Gulmarg recording the coldest at  $-4.3^{\circ}\text{C}$ .
