## India's First Survey on River Dolphin Population

India's first comprehensive river dolphin population survey, conducted from 2021 to 2023, recorded a total of 6,327 dolphins across the Ganga, Brahmaputra, and Beas river basins. Led by the Wildlife Institute of India (WII) and various state forest departments, the survey covered 8,506 km. Of the total, 6,324 were Gangetic dolphins, primarily found in Uttar Pradesh and Bihar, while 3 Indus dolphins were recorded in Punjab. The Project Dolphin initiative, launched by PM Modi in 2020, aims to enhance conservation efforts.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi inaugurated Vantara, an advanced animal rescue and conservation center in Jamnagar, Gujarat, highlighting wildlife conservation efforts. During his visit, he explored the state-of-the-art wildlife hospital, interacted with rescued animals, and observed medical procedures. He met rare species, including Asiatic Lion cubs, Clouded Leopards, and Snow Tigers. The center focuses on conserving endangered species like Asiatic Lions and Snow Leopards. Modi emphasized India's commitment to protecting biodiversity and preserving endangered species for future generations.

## NASA's IM-2 Mission

NASA's IM-2 mission, launched on February 26, 2025, focuses on exploring the lunar south pole's Mons Mouton for water ice and rare minerals essential for future lunar bases. The mission also aims to deploy the first-ever 4G/LTE network on the Moon, developed by Nokia. Using the Athena lander, the mission will mine lunar resources, deploy communication technology, and test tools for sustained human presence. Successful outcomes could enhance lunar habitation and support future Mars missions.

## India Leads New Global Alliance for Sustainable Growth

India launched the Cities Coalition for Circularity (C-3) on March 3, 2025, to promote sustainable urban development through city-to-city collaboration and private sector partnerships. The initiative focuses on waste management, resource efficiency, and circular economy practices, aligning with India's Pro-Planet People (P-3) approach. C-3 aims to unite global nations for knowledge-sharing, while a working group will finalize its framework. An MoU in Jaipur secured ₹1,800 crore for 18 cities to serve as models for urban sustainability.

## Supreme Court Emphasizes Disability Rights as Fundamental

On March 4, 2025, the Supreme Court of India ruled that the right against disability-based discrimination is a fundamental right, aligning with the Rights of Persons with Disabilities (RPwD) Act, 2016. The court allowed visually impaired candidates to participate in judicial service recruitment, striking down discriminatory rules in Madhya Pradesh and Rajasthan. The judgment emphasized reasonable accommodation, equal opportunities, and relaxation of eligibility criteria for persons with disabilities, reinforcing their rights to access public services and pursue careers in law.

## India and Nepal have signed a MoU to enhance collaboration in the WASH

On March 3, 2025, India and Nepal signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) to enhance cooperation in the Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene (WASH) sector, focusing on clean drinking water, sanitation, and waste management. The agreement includes capacity-building initiatives, technology exchange, and joint projects on groundwater management. Signed in New Delhi, the MoU aims to strengthen public health and sustainability, fostering regional collaboration. The agreement reflects both nations' commitment to improving WASH services and resource management.

## Rupee112 Introduces India's First Fully Automated Loan Disbursal via WhatsApp

In February 2025, Gurugram-based fintech startup Rupee112 launched India's first fully automated loan disbursal service via WhatsApp. The service enables salaried professionals to access unsecured loans between Rs 5,000 and Rs 1,00,000 with no paperwork. Using AI and ML, the platform verifies user information in real-time and transfers funds directly to bank accounts within minutes, significantly reducing approval times. This innovation highlights AI's increasing role in simplifying digital lending and streamlining the loan process.

## Women's Credit Monitoring Increases by 42%, Reaching 27 Million in 2024

On March 3, 2025, NITI Aayog's Women Entrepreneurship Platform (WEP), in collaboration with TransUnion CIBIL and MicroSave Consulting, released the report "From Borrowers to Builders: Women's Role in India's Financial Growth Story." The report highlights a 42% increase in women's credit monitoring, reaching 27 million by December 2024. Women in non-metro regions showed higher growth, while Gen Z led credit monitoring. Business loans to women grew significantly, and regional disparities were noted, with the southern states leading in self-monitoring women.
