### Kiren Rijiju Launches Haj Suvidha App 2.0



The induction ceremony of the sixth Missile Cum Ammunition Barge, LSAM 12 (Yard 80), was held at Naval Dockyard, Mumbai, presided over by Cmde Abhirup Majumdar. Built by M/s SECON Engineering Projects Pvt. Ltd., the barges are indigenously designed and model-tested for seaworthiness. The induction of these barges, part of the 'Make in India' and 'Aatmanirbhar Bharat' initiatives, will enhance the Indian Navy's operational capabilities.

# New Atlas Maps Skeletal Development and Genetic Insights

A new atlas mapping human skeletal development provides insights into bone formation, genetic links to arthritis, and conditions like craniosynostosis. Researchers from the Wellcome Sanger Institute used advanced genomic techniques to identify cells involved in early skeletal development. The study, published in Nature, highlights how cartilage acts as a scaffold for bone growth and explores genetic mutations linked to conditions like hip arthritis and skull malformations, offering potential diagnostic and therapeutic targets.



### ESA's Proba-3 Mission to Launch on ISRO's PSLV

The European Space Agency's Proba-3 mission, launching on ISRO's PSLV on December 4, is the world's first precision formation flying mission. Two satellites will fly in a fixed formation, with one spacecraft blocking the Sun to reveal its coronal atmosphere. This will allow scientists to study space weather. Proba-3's instruments will provide extended views of the Sun's corona, offering a breakthrough in solar research.




# One Health and Climate Hub to Tackle Climate Change Health Impact



Singh, who won bronze in the 2023 Hangzhou Asian Games, also holds the national record for the 5000m, which he broke in September 2024.
