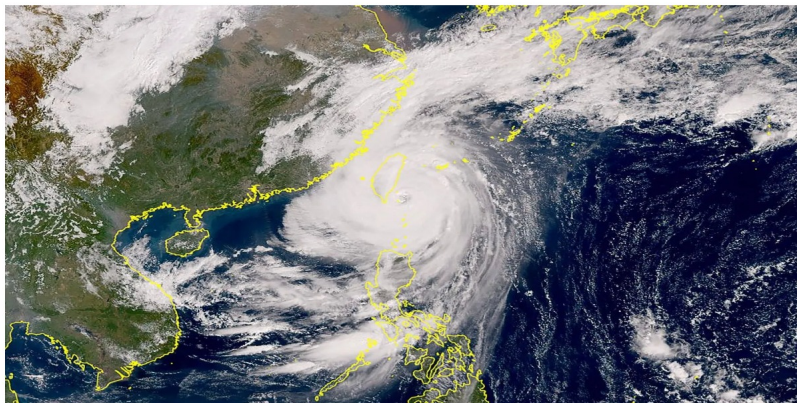

Typhoon Kong-rey batters Taiwan with powerful winds and destruction

Typhoon Kong-rey made landfall in Taiwan on October 31, 2024, becoming the largest typhoon to hit the island in nearly 30 years. With peak winds over 200 km/h, it caused significant disruptions, leading to the closure of schools, offices, and markets, and prompting the evacuation of thousands from high-risk areas. The storm injured over 70 people and caused widespread power outages affecting around 500,000 households. The government has mobilized troops for rescue efforts and advised residents to stay indoors as Kong-rey gradually weakens.

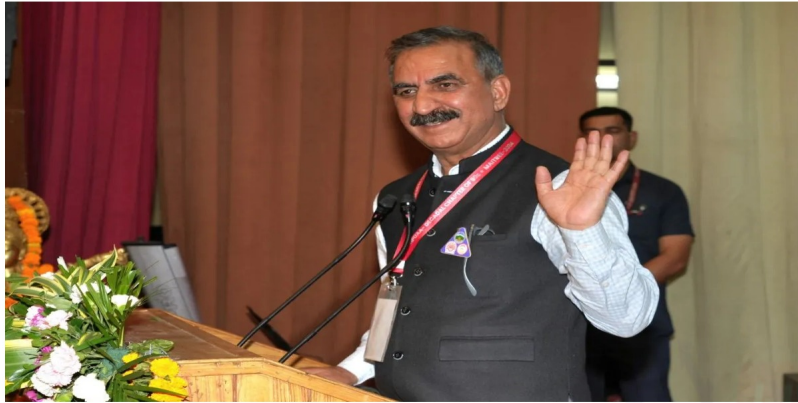

Durgesh Aranya Zoological Park aims for India's first IGBC certification

Himachal Pradesh Chief Minister Sukhvinder Singh Sukhu announced on October 30, 2024, that Durgesh Aranya Zoological Park in Kangra will be the first zoo in India to receive certification from the Indian Green Building Council (IGBC). This certification highlights the park's commitment to sustainable infrastructure and ecological balance. Covering 25 hectares with a total development cost of ₹619 crore, the zoo will feature 73 animal species, including Asiatic lions and crocodiles, and aims to boost tourism and local employment opportunities.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi commenced a two-day visit to Gujarat on October 30, 2024, focusing on Ekta Nagar, where he inaugurated projects worth over ₹284 crore in the Narmada district. Key developments include tourism centres, a sewage treatment plant, and a new 50-bed hospital. Sustainable initiatives involve a 4-megawatt solar project and a flood defence wall extension. Modi also addressed officer trainees, emphasizing the roadmap for a self-reliant India. These projects aim to enhance tourism, public facilities, and sustainable development in Ekta Nagar, home to the Statue of Unity.
