Nvidia has surpassed Apple to become the world's most valuable company, briefly reaching a market value of \$3.53 trillion, driven by soaring demand for its AI supercomputing chips. October saw an 18% stock rise, bolstered by strong earnings from TSMC and OpenAI's funding announcement. While analysts remain optimistic about Nvidia's long-term prospects, concerns linger about revenue sustainability amidst heightened investor enthusiasm and market speculation surrounding AI advancements.

On October 25, 2024, the Indian Navy launched its seventh Anti-Submarine Warfare Shallow Water Craft, 'Abhay,' at L&T's Kattupalli facility, Tamil Nadu. Built by Garden Reach Shipbuilders & Engineers, this vessel enhances India's maritime defense. The project includes eight ships, replacing the older Abhay class. Designed for coastal anti-submarine operations, 'Abhay' features advanced tracking and armament systems. Its launch highlights India's Aatmanirbhar Bharat initiative, with over 80% indigenous content, boosting local defense production.

Meta Collaborates with IndiaAI

Meta has partnered with IndiaAI and the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology to enhance AI in India through open-source research and skill development. Key initiatives include establishing a Generative AI Center at IIT Jodhpur and the "AI for Skilling and Capacity Building" program, aiming to train 100,000 youth in AI. Meta has committed up to Rs 750 lakhs over three years, supporting India's goal of fostering a sustainable AI ecosystem and bridging the talent gap.

NTPC and Indian Army join hands for sustainable energy solutions in Ladakh

NTPC has partnered with the Indian Army to create a solar hydrogen microgrid in Chushul, Ladakh, aimed at providing a stable, sustainable power supply for off-grid Army locations. Laid by Defence Minister Rajnath Singh, the project will replace diesel generators with a 200 kW renewable energy solution, operational year-round despite harsh winter conditions. NTPC will maintain the system for 25 years, promoting self-sufficiency and reducing carbon emissions while supporting future hydrogen initiatives in the region.

Airbus Unveils Cutting-Edge Headquarters and Training Center in India

Airbus has launched its new India and South Asia Headquarters and Training Centre in the National Capital Region, marking a significant investment in the aerospace sector. Equipped with four A320 simulators, the facility aims to train up to 800 pilots and 200 technicians annually. CEO Michael Schoellhorn emphasized its role in fostering India's aerospace ecosystem, while Civil Aviation Minister Ram Mohan Naidu outlined plans to expand the country's aviation infrastructure and pilot training capacity significantly.

With a distinguished academic career at IISc Bangalore, she received multiple honors, including the French National Medal of Merit, leaving a significant legacy in both research and advocacy for women in STEM.

EIB Approves ₹2,800 Crore Funding for Bengaluru Suburban Railway

The European Investment Bank (EIB Global) has approved a €300 million (approximately ₹2,800 crore) loan to develop a new suburban railway network in Bengaluru, featuring four rail corridors covering 149 km, with plans for 58 stations. EIB Vice-President Nicola Beer emphasized the project's role in reducing road congestion, air pollution, and greenhouse gas emissions while improving mobility. With Bengaluru's population projected to reach 2 crore by 2030, the railway aims to significantly lower CO2 emissions and accommodate up to 14 lakh daily trips by 2040.

Peak Energy CEO Gavin Adda highlighted Asia's potential in solar and storage, emphasizing collaboration to achieve sustainability goals in the renewable sector.

Mudra Loan Limit Increased to ₹20 Lakh

The government has doubled the Mudra loan limit under the Pradhan Mantri Mudra Yojana (PMMY) from ₹10 lakh to ₹20 lakh, introducing a new category called 'Tarun Plus.' Announced by Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman in July 2024, this change aims to empower entrepreneurs who have successfully repaid previous loans. The scheme has historically facilitated easy, collateral-free access to credit, with over 487.8 million loans sanctioned since its inception, reflecting improved recovery rates in recent years.
