## Lake Prespa

The Little Lake Prespa located on the Albanian-Greek Border is slowly drying up. Lake Prespa is one of the oldest tectonic lakes in Europe and the highest lake in the Balkan Peninsula. The Lake is made up of Great Prespa Lake (Albania, Greece and Republic of Macedonia) and Small Prespa Lake. The major reasons for the drying up of the lake are attributed to rising temperatures and increasingly mild winters with little snowfall and scarcity of precipitation.

## Anna DARPAN Project

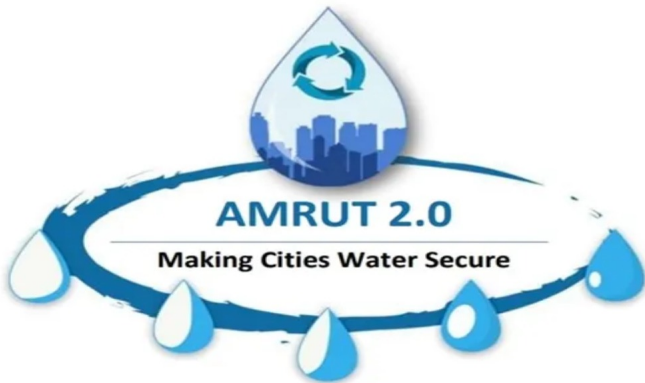
