India becomes a member of the International Energy Efficiency Hub

The Union Cabinet chaired by Prime Minister of India Shri Narendra Modi recently approved India's membership to the International Energy Efficiency Hub. International Energy Efficiency Hub is a global platform for promoting energy efficiency worldwide and was established in 2020 as a successor to the International Partnership for Energy Efficiency Cooperation (IPEEC). It consists of 16 member countries and the Bureau of Energy Efficiency has been designated as the implementing agency for the Hub.

The Forum was established in 2011 with the aim of adopting international medical device regulatory harmonisation and convergence. It is a group of major medical device regulators including regulatory authorities from Canada, the EU, the UK, the US, Australia, Japan, Russia, Brazil, China, South Korea, Singapore and the World Health Organisation.

5 new languages added to Classical Languages List

The Union Cabinet recently approved the conferring of Classical Language status to 5 new languages namely Marathi, Pali, Prakrit, Assamese and Bengali. The criteria to become a classical language were established by the Linguistic Experts Committee. Currently, there are 11 classical languages listed under Schedule 8 of the Constitution of India.

The agreement allows the UK to retain the sovereign rights over Diego Garcia where a joint UK-US military base would be established.
