1.2 lakh D-Voter in Assam

The Assam Chief Minister Shri Himanta Biswas recently announced that more than 40 thousand voters are declared as foreigners whereas 1.32 lakh people have been identified as D (Doubtful or Dubious) voters. The D-Vote is a unique concept in Assam where persons whose citizenship was doubtful were categorised as D-Voters. It was introduced in 1997 in Assam by the Election Commission of India.

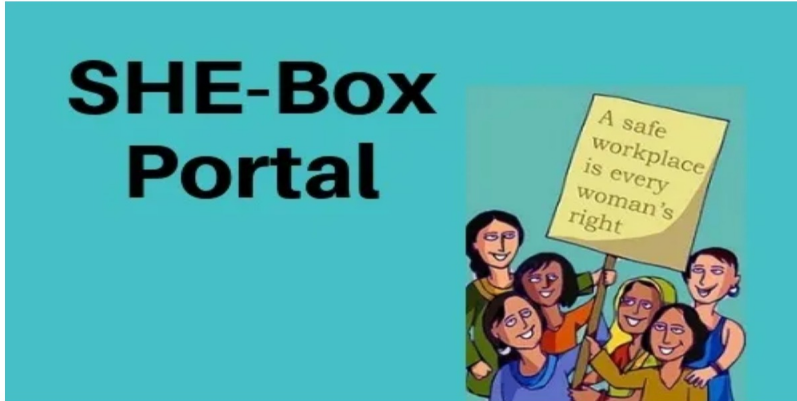

Solar Paraboloid Technology

Solar Paraboloid Technology is an advanced form of concentrating solar power (CSP) that enhances the efficiency of solar energy capture. It operates using the Parabolic Trough Collector (PTC) system which consists of long, Parabolic mirrors that focus sunlight onto a receiver tube placed at the focal line of the mirror.

Sabina Shoal

The first survey report of the South China Sea's disputed Sabina Shoal also known as Xianbin Reef was recently released by China's Natural Resource Ministry. Sabina Shoal is an Oceanic coral atoll located within the Exclusive Economic Zone of Philippines under the 1982 UN Convention on the Law of the Sea. Although within the EEZ of the Philippines, China claims the shoal as its sovereign territory.

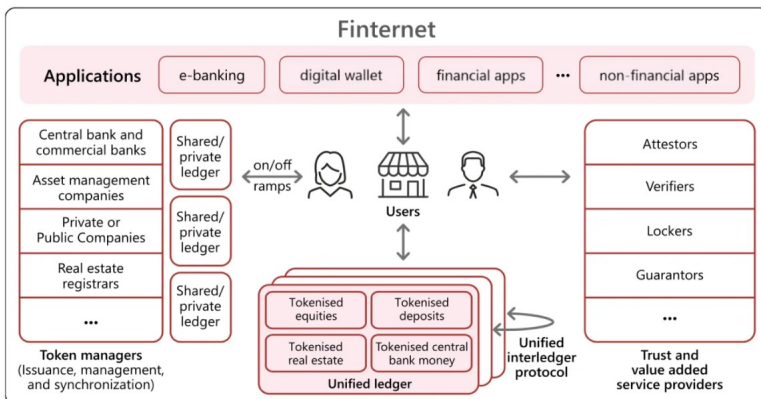

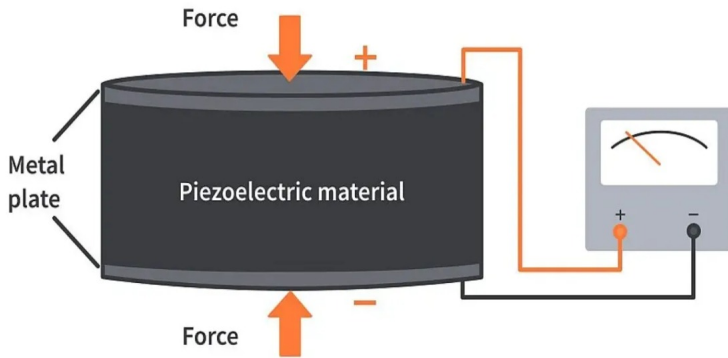

Security alert system based on Piezoelectric Polymer

Scientists from National Chemical Laboratory (CSIR-NCL) in collaboration with Researchers from Centre for Nano and Soft Matter sciences (CeNS) have developed a Security alert system based on Piezoelectric Polymer nanocomposite. The Polymers can generate electric charges on the surface under pressure and strain. The material can withstand much higher driving fields than ceramics.
