## India Clinches Historic Gold in Men's Compound Archery at World Championships

India created history by winning its first-ever gold medal in the men's compound team event at the 2025 World Archery Championships in Gwangju, South Korea. The Indian trio of Rishabh Yadav, Aman Saini, and Prathamesh Fuge defeated France 235–233 in a tense final. A tactical change in shooting order by coach Jiwanjot Singh Teja proved crucial. Yadav also won silver in the mixed team event with Jyothi Surekha Vennam. However, the women's team ended their medal streak with a pre-quarterfinal exit.

## India Launches \$125 Billion High-Speed Road Network Plan

India has launched a massive infrastructure plan worth ₹11 lakh crore (\$125 billion) to construct 17,000 km of high-speed access-controlled expressways by 2033, led by the Ministry of Road Transport and Highways. The project will expand India's expressway network from 4,500 km to 21,500 km, cutting logistics costs and boosting connectivity. Financing will follow BOT and HAM models, with greater private participation. About 40% of the corridors are already under construction, while the rest will begin by 2028.

## PNB Signs ₹21,000 Cr MoU with Rajasthan for Development Boost

Punjab National Bank (PNB) signed a ₹21,000 crore MoU with the Rajasthan government under the Rising Rajasthan initiative to promote socio-economic growth. The partnership focuses on MSMEs, women entrepreneurs, and digital financial inclusion. The agreement was signed in Jaipur in the presence of CM Bhajan Lal Sharma and PNB MD and CEO Ashok Chandra. As part of the rollout, PNB distributed 2,000 loan sanction letters to women entrepreneurs, highlighting its commitment to grassroots development, financial literacy, and digital banking transformation.

## Russia Unveils Colon Cancer Vaccine After Successful Trials

Russia's Federal Medical Biological Agency (FMBA) has announced a breakthrough colon cancer vaccine after successful preclinical trials, revealed at the 10th Eastern Economic Forum in Vladivostok. The vaccine demonstrated 60–80% tumour reduction, slowed progression, improved survival, and showed no adverse effects. Designed as a therapeutic vaccine, it activates the immune system to target colorectal cancer cells. Pending regulatory approval, it could be Russia's first public immunotherapy for colorectal cancer. FMBA is also developing vaccines for glioblastoma and melanoma.

## International Literacy Day 2025

International Literacy Day (ILD) 2025 was observed globally on 8 September with the theme "Promoting Literacy in the Digital Era." Established by UNESCO in 1966 and first celebrated in 1967, the day emphasizes literacy as a fundamental human right and a driver of sustainable development. ILD 2025 highlights digital literacy, critical thinking, safe online engagement, and inclusivity in an increasingly digital world. The main event was held at UNESCO Headquarters in Paris, stressing global efforts to reduce illiteracy affecting over 739 million people.

## India to Host 28th Asian Table Tennis Team Championships 2025

India will host the 28th ITTF-ATTU Asian Table Tennis Team Championships from October 11–15, 2025, in Bhubaneswar, Odisha. This continental event features men's and women's team competitions and serves as a qualifier for the 2026 ITTF World Team Championships, with the top 13 teams earning direct entry. Governed by ITTF and ATTU, the championship provides global visibility, qualification opportunities, and showcases India's sports infrastructure. Bhubaneswar, hosting an Asian-level TT event for the first time, will follow international standards with advanced facilities.

The award was presented by Julia Ducournau, Orizzonti Jury President. Roy's win marks a significant achievement for Indian independent cinema and women directors, enhancing global recognition of socially conscious, non-mainstream storytelling from India.

## Kokichi Akuzawa, 102, Oldest to Climb Mount Fuji

Kokichi Akuzawa, aged 102, became the oldest man to summit Mount Fuji, Japan's tallest mountain (3,776 meters), on August 5, 2025, earning a Guinness World Record. Despite health challenges like heart issues and shingles, he trained rigorously for three months and climbed with his 70-year-old daughter, granddaughter, her husband, and fellow climbers. This was not his first record; he previously held it at age 96. His achievement highlights perseverance, intergenerational support, and challenges stereotypes about aging and lifelong fitness.

## India Beats Korea in 2025 Asia Cup Final, Qualifies for World Cup

India won the 2025 Men's Hockey Asia Cup by defeating South Korea 4-1 in the final held at Rajgir Sports Complex, Bihar, on 7 September 2025. Sukhjeet Singh scored within 30 seconds, followed by two goals from Dilpreet Singh and a final strike by Amit Rohidas. This victory, India's fourth Asia Cup title after 2003, 2007, and 2017, ends an eight-year title drought and secures direct qualification for the 2026 FIH Men's Hockey World Cup, co-hosted by Belgium and the Netherlands.
