## Indian Army's SAMBHAV Enhances Secure Communication in Operation Sindoor

The Indian Army deployed its indigenously developed mobile ecosystem, SAMBHAV (Secure Army Mobile Bharat Version), during Operation Sindoor, replacing unsecured platforms like WhatsApp to safeguard mission-critical communications. Chief of the Army Staff, Gen. Upendra Dwivedi, confirmed its use. SAMBHAV features end-to-end, multi-layered encryption and operates on 5G-ready handsets, functioning effectively across public networks like Airtel and Jio. Equipped with secure apps like M-Sigma and provisions like preloaded key contact lists, the system marks a significant step in self-reliant, secure defense communications.

The proposed HIRE Act 2025 would levy a 25 percent excise tax on payments that US companies make to foreign providers for services benefiting US consumers, while disallowing related deductions. This would sharply raise the cost of offshoring, especially to India, which counts on exports to the US for over half of its IT revenue. If enacted, Indian tech firms may see reduced margins and demand, prompting strategic shifts like automation, client cost-sharing, and onshore moves.

## Indian Navy Commissions Eleventh ACTCM Barge LSAM Twenty Five

The Indian Navy recently launched its 11th Ammunition-Cum-Torpedo-Cum-Missile (ACTCM) barge, designated LSAM 25 (Yard 135), on 8 September 2025 at Suryadipta Projects Pvt Ltd in Thane. Constructed by an MSME in collaboration with an Indian design firm and certified by the Indian Register of Shipping, the vessel underwent seaworthiness testing at NSTL, Visakhapatnam. It marks the tenth delivery under a contract signed in March 2021 for eleven barges, all now bolstering the Navy's logistical and operational supply capabilities.

## Asia Cup 2025 Schedule Released with Key Matches Timings and Venues

Asia Cup 2025 will be held in the United Arab Emirates from 9 to 28 September, featuring eight teams split into two groups. Matches will be held at venues in Dubai and Abu Dhabi, including the Dubai International Cricket Stadium and Sheikh Zayed Stadium. Group stage matches run from 9 to 19 September, followed by a Super Four phase through 26 September, and culminating in the final on 28 September. Key fixtures include India vs UAE on September 10 and the high-stakes India vs Pakistan match on September 14.

## Himachal Pradesh to Get Financial Relief Package of Fifteen Hundred Crore from Centre

The central government has announced a financial relief package of fifteen hundred crore rupees for Himachal Pradesh in response to the recent cloudbursts, floods, and landslides.
