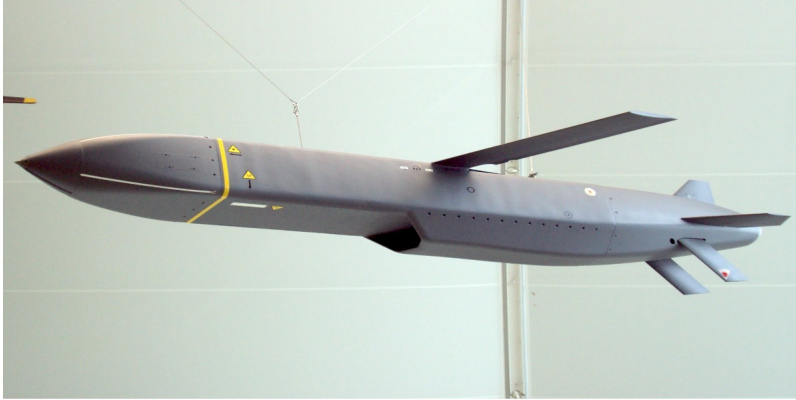

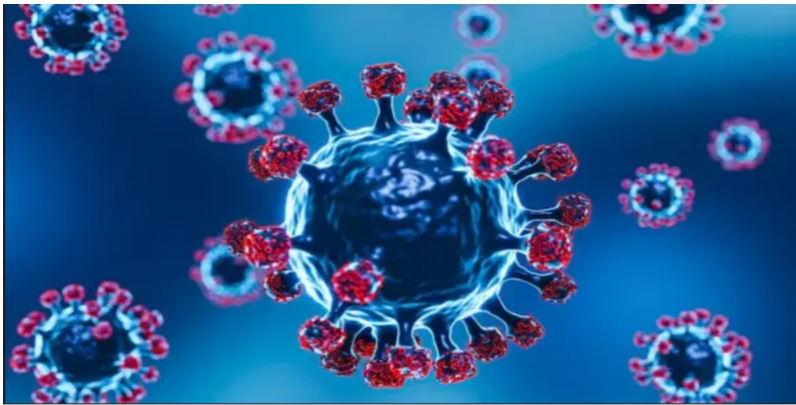

## Ozone pollution slows Tropical Forest growth

A New study published in journal Nature Geoscience has revealed that Ozone pollution slows Tropical Forest growth by halting Carbon absorption. It has led to the loss of nearly 300 million tonnes of Carbon each year. Tropical forests are located in tropical zones surrounding the equator and it makes up 6% of Earth's Land surface area. These types of forests have dense upper canopy of broad leader trees and more than 50% of land based plant and animal species on earth can be found in Tropical forests.
