## Cellulitis disease spread in Karimnagar



## New species of Parasitoid wasp discovered

Researchers from Mississippi State University, US have recently discovered a new species of Parasitoid wasp namely Syntretus Perlmani. The species matures inside living adult fruit flies before bursting out. It is the first wasp to infect adult fruit flies and they are considered as Parasitoids as they always kill their hosts. These Parasitoids use a specialised organ called Ovipositor to inject eggs directly into Fruit flies.

# 127th anniversary of Battle of Saragarhi




