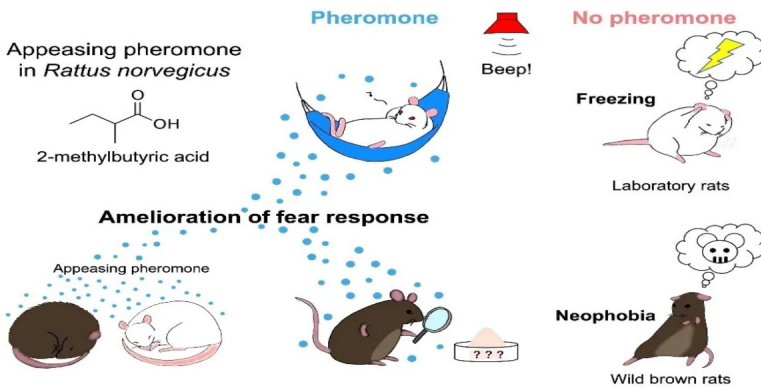

Indian scientists develop Pheromone dispenser

Researchers in India have created an eco-friendly pheromone dispenser featuring a regulated release mechanism, presenting a novel approach to significantly lower the expenses associated with pest control and management. To maximize the benefits of this innovation for farmers on a broad scale, the Jawaharlal Nehru Centre for Advanced Scientific Research (JNCASR) in Bengaluru and the ICAR–National Bureau of Agricultural Insect Resources (ICAR–NBAIR) have recently established a Know-how licensing agreement with Krishi Vikas Sahakari Samiti Ltd. (KVSSL) in Haryana.

India's first astronaut set for Axiom-4 mission

Shubhanshu Shukla and Prashanth Balakrishnan Nair, two Indian astronaut-designates, are preparing in the United States for the Axiom Space Ax-4 mission. Shukla has been assigned by ISRO to the Ax-4 mission, with Nair serving as a backup. This mission, which is scheduled to launch from Florida's Kennedy Space Centre, will be India's second government-sponsored human spaceflight in the past forty years, following Rakesh Sharma.

China's Chang'e mission

China's Chang'e-6 mission, which was launched in May, returned soil samples from the moon's far side, signalling an important turning point in lunar exploration. The first expedition of its kind to successfully gather material from this understudied area is this one. Chinese scientists analysed the samples and found that they had "distinct characteristics" from those from other sections of the moon. These findings provide new information about the geological history of the moon.
