ABHED Bulletproof Jacket

The researchers at the Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) Delhi along with DRDO have developed a Lightweight Bulletproof jacket named Advanced Ballistics for High Energy Defeat (ABHED). The jacket has been created from polymers and indigenous boron carbide ceramic. These jackets weigh 8 kg to 9.3 kg and are capable of mitigating the highest threat levels.

10th World Free Zones Organisation Congress


