Technical Textiles export to cross USD 10 billion by 2030


The Union Minister for Textiles recently stated that the annual exports of Technical Textiles will exceed USD 10 billion mark.by 2030. These textiles are defined as textiles that can be used for technical performance and functional properties. They are also known as Functional Textiles, Performance Textiles, engineering textiles and hi-tech textiles. The National Technical Textiles Mission was launched to promote Technical Textiles by the Union Ministry of Textiles.

BPaLM regimen

The BPaLM regimen was recently introduced under the National TB Elimination Program (NTEP) to treat Multidrug Resistant Tuberculosis. The regimen was introduced by the Union Ministry of Health and Family Welfare. The regimen combines four durga namely Linezolid, Moxifloxacin, Bedaquiline and Pretomanid. The NTEP is a Centrally sponsored scheme with an ambitious goal of eliminating TB by 2025.

The Strategic Forces Command (SFC) have recently conducted a successful test fire of Agni-4 Ballistic Missile in Odisha. The Strategic Forces Command is a part of India's Nuclear Command Authority (NCA) and was established on January 4, 2003. The Agni-4 Missile is an Intermediate range ballistic missile and can hit as far as 4000 kms. It is a surface to surface, two-stage solid fuel system developed by DRDO.

The Central Government is set to auction a parcel of land in Uttar Pradesh belonging to the family of Former Pakistan President Pervez Musharraf under the Enemy Property Act. The act came into force in 1968 defined "Enemy" as a country or citizen that committed external aggression against India. The Parliament passed the Enemy Property (Amendment and Validation) Bill 2016 that amended the 1968 act.
