The proximity of the sea, combined with the construction activities, left the old aquarium in a state of disrepair.

Dr. Atul Patne, the Commissioner of the Maharashtra Department of Fisheries, stated, "Besides chances of corrosion of the old-age structure, owing to the proximity of the sea, the coastal road project has also impacted the structure severely." As a result, the decision was made to dismantle the old structure, opening the door for something new and extraordinary.
