The team celebrates the victory of the armed forces in the Kargil war and pays tribute to the soldiers who made the greatest sacrifice in the service of the nation.

## About Distance and Destination



The rally will cover a total distance of 1,000 kilometers, with the team crossing the plains of Haryana and Punjab, and the high mountain passes of Jammu and Kashmir, and Ladakh to reach the Kargil war memorial in Dras, Ladakh on 25 July 2023.
